Subject: Clarification regarding documents to be submitted by sugar mills at the time of submission of their claims to avail assistance under the "Scheme for defraying expenditure towards internal transport, freight handling and other charges on export for sugar season 2018-19" in case of deemed export of sugar.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to representation dated 08.02.2019 from Indian Biscuits Manufacturers' Association (IBMA) regarding above noted subject.

2. The matter has been examined in the Department. In case of deemed export of sugar, the submission of documents viz. shipping bills indicating Let Export Order (LEO) date, BRCs, bill of lading has been dispensed off at the time of filing their claim to avail assistance under the "Scheme for defraying expenditure towards internal transport, freight handling and other charges on export for sugar season 2018-19". However, in place of BRC, sugar mills are required to submit copy of their bank statement in which payment is realized from the sale proceeds of sugar. Rest of the documents mentioned in the scheme notification are continue to remain as the prescribed documents.
