**Subject: Export performance of sugar mills against Maximum Admissible Export Quantity (MAEQ) for export during Sugar Season 2019-20-reg.**

Madam/Sir,

The Central Government, with a view to facilitate export of sugar during the sugar season 2019-20 and to improve the liquidity position of sugar mills and thereby enabling them to clear cane price dues of farmers for sugar season 2019-20, has notified on 12.09.2019 a Scheme for providing assistance to sugar mills for expenses on marketing costs including handling, upgrading and other processing costs and costs of international and internal transport and freight charges on export of sugar. Subsequently, this Department vide order dated 16.09.2019, has allocated mill-wise MAEQ of 60 Lakh MT of sugar for export during the current sugar season 2019-20.

2. Out of 60 LMT, about 53 LMT of sugar has been lifted from sugar mills (as on 31.07.2020). The Government has a target of exporting 60 LMT of sugar by 30.09.2020. Only about one and a half months are now left & still 7 LMT of sugar is to be exported. Therefore, all sugar mills are advised to participate in the export scheme & should export the balance quantity of their export quotas by 30.09.2020. However, those sugar mills which do not intend to export their MAEQ/ revised MAEQ, partly or fully, may relinquish the quantity & inform this department by 25.08.2020. **All sugar mills are requested to provide information (in the enclosed proforma) about the progress of export made till 20.08.2020 to this department latest by 25.08.2020.** The information may be sent through E-mail at : [dtesug.fpd@nic.in](mailto:dtesug.fpd@nic.in).
