ORDER

In exercise of powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955) read with clause 4 and 5 of the Sugar (Control) Order, 1966 and Order S.O. No.2347 (E) dated 07.06.2018, stock holding limit is being issued individually for all the cooperative sugar mills across the country. The representation received by Uttar Pradesh Sahakari Chini Mills Sangh has been examined and in view of the release quota being lapsed for various co-operative sugar mills of State Government of Uttar Pradesh due to uneven demand and supply in the market; it has been decided that a combined quota may be considered for all these 24 co-operative sugar mills. Uttar Pradesh Sahakari Chini Mills Sangh is allowed to maintain the Stock holding limit in respect of their 24 co-operative sugar mills in various regions of the State of Uttar Pradesh on a combined basis, irrespective of the intra-state locations of the sugar mills.

2. Any violation of this order would attract the penal provisions under the Essential Commodities Act, 1955, as amended from time to time.
