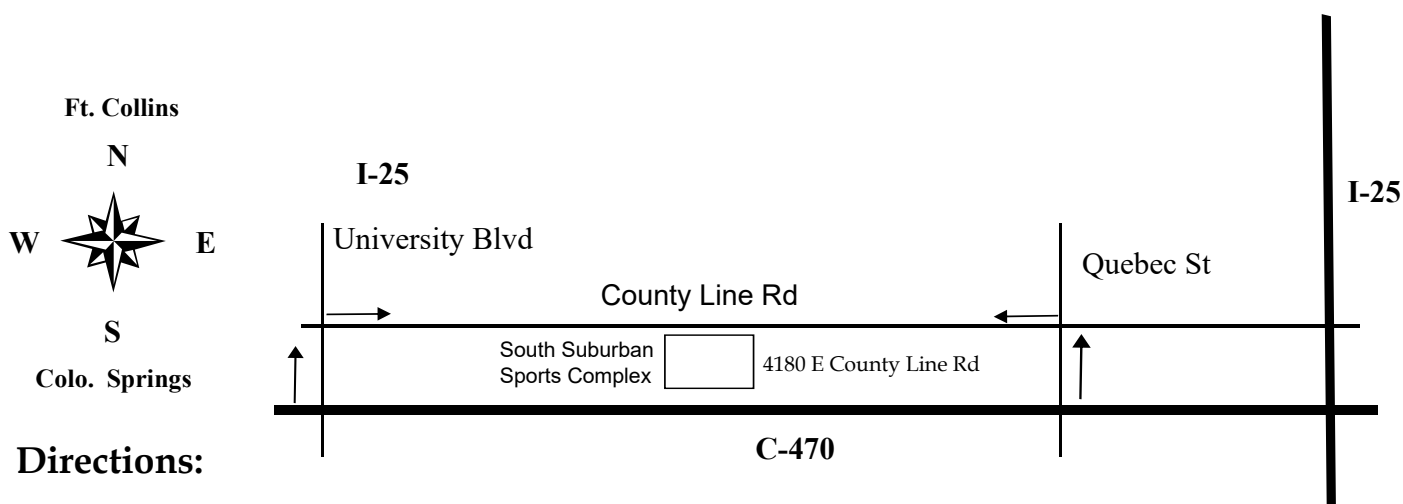

- **From Ft. Collins** - I-25 south to C-470 West. Exit Quebec Street and go North. Turn Left on County Line Rd to the South Suburban Sports Complex located on your left
- **From Colorado Springs** - I-25 north to C-470 West. Exit Quebec Street and go North. Turn Left on County Line Rd to the South Suburban Sports Complex located on your left
- If coming from C-470 Eastbound or if you miss Quebec Street Westbound, exit on University Blvd and go North. Turn Right on County Line Rd to the South Suburban Sports Complex located on your right.

Colorado Classic Schedule of Events

We are trying a new schedule in an effort to keep rings and divisions running in a timely manner and avoid the conflicts that we have run into in the past where a competitor is asked to compete in two rings at the same time and one ring is being held up because of the conflict. As you can see from the following pages, each age group 5-8, 9-11, 12-14 and 15-17 will all start in a dedicated ring at 9:30 am. Our goal is to start with all of the divisions where all competitors in that age group compete together. This will hopefully eliminate or reduce the number of conflicts as we move forward through the day. As always, PLEASE LISTEN FOR RING CHANGES as we may move certain divisions around to keep things moving.

COVID Protocols

The South Suburban Sports Complex is located in Douglas County which has opted out of Tri County Health Department regulations as of April 16th. In essence, Douglas County has left occupancy levels up to individual businesses to determine best practices and, per the venue, as of April 23rd, there is no occupancy limit. As we get closer to the tournament date we will provide an update on the venue's policy. We are still asking all judges, volunteers and spectators to wear masks and maintain adequate social protocols during this event. Competitors should wear masks except when competing (optional). We will have hand sanitizer, lysol spray and chlorox wipes at every ring for everyone to use and encourage all competitors to clean their gear after each use. Let's make this a safe and fun event so we can continue promoting tournaments year after year.

Coaching

Coaching is allowed at the Colorado Classic. Coaching passes can be purchased at a reduced price in pre-registration or at the registration desk the day of the tournament. Please remember the judges can and will check to insure all coaches have a coaches pass.

Spectators

All spectators should have an adult or child/senior spectator pass which can be purchased at a reduced price in pre-registration or at the registration desk the day of the tournament. We will have bleachers set up throughout the tournament for spectator use. Please avoid spectating from the competition floor and remember to use social distancing protocols whenever possible.
