Davis President We are trying a new schedule in an effort to keep rings and divisions running in a timely manner and avoid the conflicts that we have run into in the past where a competitor is asked to compete in two rings at the same time and one ring is being held up because of the conflict. As you can see from the following pages, each age group 5-8, 9-11, 12-14 and 15-17 will all start in a dedicated ring at 9:30 am. Our goal is to start with all of the divisions where all competitors in that age group compete together. This will hopefully eliminate or reduce the number of comflicts as we move forward through the day. As always, PLEASE LISTEN FOR RING CHANGES as we may move certain divisions around to keep things moving.

Coaching

Coaching is allowed. Coaching passes can be purchased at a reduced price in pre-registration or at the registration desk the day of the tournament. Please remember the judges can and will check to insure all coaches have a coaches pass.

Spectators

All spectators should have an adult or child/senior spectator pass which can be purchased at a reduced price in pre-registration or at the registration desk the day of the tournament. We will have bleachers set up throughout the tournament for spectator use. Please avoid spectating from the competition floor and remember to use social distancing protocols whenever possible.
