

Rules

- 1. Face Shield is required for all competitors under the age of 18 for sparring.
- 2. Large divisions will now be split at over 16 competitors rather than at 20 competitors
- 3. Wooden Bow is required in Traditional Weapons Forms.

 Traditional Wood Bow are considered natural wood color.
- 4. Music is not allowed in Creative Forms or Creative Weapons Divisions.
- 5. Adult Brown/Black Belts must judge throughout the tournament to have their competition fee waived.
- 6. Scores will be given once all forms competitors have performed their form.
- 7. Any participants under the age of 5, participating in Flying Dragon's Division, will not count towards tournament experience.


