

DCWC Skeet, Trap, and Clays Certification Process - January 2023

Shotgun 101

Mandatory for Skeet, Trap and Clays shotgun shooters

Held monthly @ 3:00 pm on the first Friday and on the Saturday following safety classes.

Pre-registration is required - email wyattcurrin170@gmail.com and provide the following:

Name, email address, phone number, and desired class

Shotgun 101 is the DCWC shotgun orientation course. It is required for **all shotgun shooters**, regardless of experience. It provides a hands-on introduction to shotgun safety with an emphasis on safe gun handling and shooting. It also provides an introduction to basic shotgun shooting techniques. At the end you will receive a **Red Card** that is needed for the next steps.



Skeet 102

Requires **Red Card** or **Trap Certification** and pre-registration; see [calendar](#) for schedule.

Covers safety, off-hours sign-in, sign-out and payment, safety, opening and closing skeet houses, loading machines, and skeet etiquette.



Skeet White Card - blank



Skeet 103

Complete 3 rounds of skeet in a safe manner shooting with a skeet-certified club member.

1. Focus is on safety and rules, not score
2. **Skeet White Card** is signed by the skeet-certified club member
3. Present your signed **Skeet White Card** to a Shop Manager during open hours to receive a SKEET sticker and get Skeet registered on profile.



Skeet or Trap Certification Complete

Skeet or Trap certification is now complete, and you are eligible for Clays Certification.



Clays Certification

Requires Skeet or Trap certification - See [club calendar](#) for schedule

Present badge indicating Skeet or Trap certification to a Clays officer to attend certification.



Trap 102/103

Requires **Red Card** or **Skeet Certification** and pre-registration; see [calendar](#) for schedule.

Note that Trap 102/103 are held together in one session

Trap 102

Covers safety, off-hours sign-in, sign-out and payment, opening and closing houses, use of the horn and lights, setting up the field, loading machines, and trap etiquette.

Trap 103

Complete 3 rounds of trap in a safe manner on field #2 during a scheduled class.

1. Focus is on safety and rules, not score
2. **Trap White Card** is finalized and signed by the trainer who gives a TRAP sticker
3. Student puts **Trap White Card** in the mailbox at the shop to get Trap registered on their profile.



Shotgun Instruction
