A few suggestions to help guide your Sunday morning as a family:

Pray – Pray before you sit down to watch the videos provided. Thank God for His mercy and grace upon your life. Pray that the Lord would sanctify His church by His word. Pray for the lost who need a Savior by name. Pray for churches and believers to be faithful during this time. Pray for others in the church that you will miss seeing this Sunday or who have a particular need for prayer.

Scripture Reading – Each week FCL systematically and publicly reads Scripture (1 Timothy 3:13). This week's reading is 1 Thessalonians 5:12-28. Read the text publicly in your home and pray in response to the truth it contains.

Worship in Song – Connected with the time of teaching are songs that particularly relate to the time of teaching. The lyrics for each song are attached to this email so that you can sing with the video.

Respond – Discuss with one another the passage that was taught. What truths did it reveal? What is a faithful response? How does it point to Christ? What elements of the gospel are found in the truth it contains? How does the text sanctify, encourage, or exhort you?
