

AIR QUALITY PERMIT NOTICE

Notice of Application

Notice is given that Appalachian Aggregates, LLC has applied to the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Air Quality, for a Construction/Modification to Permit G40-C102B for the removal of equipment, the reduction of aggregate processed, and the addition of the two following operating sites for a portable crushing unit: Mill Point Quarry, located off State Route 39 in Mill Point, Pocahontas County, West Virginia, and the Lewisburg/Alta Quarry, located at 21071 Midland Trail West in Lewisburg, Greenbrier County, West Virginia. The latitude and longitude coordinates for Mill Point Quarry are: 38.160010, -80.181652. The latitude and longitude coordinates for Alta Quarry are: 37.877466, -80.557579. The unit is currently permitted to operate at the following sites: Kelly Mountain Quarry, located on Kelly Mountain Road in Elkins, Randolph County, West Virginia; Beckley Quarry, located at 1700 N. Sandbranch Road in Mt. Hope, Raleigh County, West Virginia; and Mercer Quarry, located at 1111 Blake Road in Princeton, Mercer County, West Virginia. The latitude and longitude coordinates for Kelly Mountain Quarry are 38.89360, -79.76270. The latitude and longitude coordinates for Beckley Quarry are 37.857744, -81.249947. The latitude and longitude coordinates for Mercer Quarry are 37.3026, -81.0627.

The applicant estimates the total potential to discharge the following Regulated Air Pollutants will be: PM of 16.57 tons per year (tpy), including fugitive emissions of 10.82 tpy; PM 10 of 6.03 tpy, including fugitive emissions of 3.28 tpy; and PM2.5 of 0.78 tpy, including fugitive emissions of 0.34 tpy.

The equipment can begin operation at proposed locations under the updated permit when the permit is issued on or about the 15th day of January 2026. Written comments will be received by the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Air Quality, 601 57th Street, SE, Charleston, WV 25304, for at least 30 calendar days from the date of publication of this notice.
