# Grace? **She Passed** Away 30 Years Ago!

Three decades ago, in the almost other-planet environment of the 1990s, this was a funny joke on a Christmas movie.

Now in 2024, it almost seems like the act - even the concept - of grace has disappeared from both human vocabulary and behavior.

For those in the Christian faith and others who put stock in the ideal, grace is a gift from God that humans can - and should - choose to give to each other. St. John Paul II the Great, perhaps the greatest figure of the 20th century both religious and otherwise, said "grace has the power to make straight the paths of human love."

Billy Graham in various works, described grace as God's love expressed through support, forgiveness, and the opportunity of redemption. He also emphasized that grace is not easy. Graham said "the work of grace was the death of Christ on the Cross," then went on to say that grace is often strongest for those who suffer the slings and arrows of a hateful society for taking up the Cross or living in the example of Christ. "When you pick up the Cross of unpopularity," Graham said, "wherever you may be, you will find God's grace is there, more than sufficient to meet your every

St. Augustine wrote in City of God that "the only Son of God, while remaining unchangeably in His own proper being, clothed Himself in humanity and gave to men the spirit of His love by the meditation of a man, so that by this love men may come to Him." Most importantly, as he told Porphyry the

philosopher, "humility was the necessary condition for submission to this truth; and it is no easy task to persuade the proud necks of you philosophers to accept this yoke." The Jewish faith sees grace somewhat differently,

but not in terms unfamiliar to Christians. In the Torah version of Genesis it says of grace, which is synonymous with mercy, "Thus said the Holy One, blessed be His name! 'If I create the world with the attribute of mercy, sin will abound; and if I create it with the attribute of justice, how can the world exist? Therefore I create it with both attributes, mercy and justice, and may it thus endure"

This duality even extends to the name of God. The older "Elohim" refers to God's justice while



A good number of them will head to Robert C. Byrd while others will find a new home. This past Friday, the Mountaineers hosted their last home football game at the John Mazzei-James L. Reaser Athletic Complex.

Mountaineers involved. 





Individual commodity production is total live weight of commercial slaughter.

Commercial slaughter totaled 1,764,000 pounds live weight, down 2 percent from September 2023. Cattle slaughter totaled 1,600 head, down 100 head from the previous average live weight was up 35 pounds from the previous year, at 1,086 pounds.

#### Moroccan Orange Cake

A traditional Moroccan cake typically served for tea or breakfast, Meskouta (Moroccan) is made with ingredients you likely have on hand, and it doesn't require a mixer. Extra-virgin olive oil makes it moist on the inside and golden on the outside.

#### **INGREDIENTS**

FOR THE CAKE:

½ cup plus 2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil, more for greasing the pan

2 cups all-purpose flour

1 ½ teaspoons baking powder

½ teaspoon baking soda

1 teaspoon fine salt

<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup plus 2 tablespoons granulated sugar 2 large eggs

<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup plus 2 tablespoons Greek-style yogurt Zest of 2 oranges (about 2 tablespoons)

½ cup fresh orange juice (from about 1

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

**CREAM** 

**FOR** WHIPPED THE (OPTIONAL):

3/4 cup heavy whipping cream

1 ½ tablespoons confectioners' sugar Dark chocolate, for shaving with a vegetable peeler

#### **PREPARATION**

Heat the oven to 350 degrees. Grease a 8½-by-4½-inch loaf pan with olive oil, and line it with a sheet of parchment paper so that you have extra on the sides. (You'll use this to lift the loaf out of the pan.)

In a large bowl, whisk together the flour, baking powder, baking soda and salt until well combined. In another large bowl, whisk together the granulated sugar and eggs until well combined. Add the yogurt, olive oil, orange zest, orange juice and vanilla extract to the sugar and egg mixture, and whisk until well incorporated.

Pour the wet ingredients into the dry ingredients and gently mix using a spatula until you no longer see flecks of flour, making sure not to overmix. (The batter will be slightly lumpy.) Transfer the batter to the prepared pan, and use a spatula to spread into an even layer.

Bake for 40 to 45 minutes, or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out with some small, moist crumbs. (If the cake needs another minute or two, but is becoming too brown, tent with foil.) Allow to cool completely on a wire rack before using the parchment overhang to remove from the pan.

Make the optional whipped cream: Using a hand mixer or a stand mixer fitted with a whisk attachment, whisk the cream and the confectioners' sugar for about 2 to 3 minutes on medium-high until medium peaks begin to form. You want a spreading consistency. Cover and keep in the fridge until ready to

To serve, cut the cake in slices, top with whipped cream, if using, and garnish with chocolate shavings, if using. Alternatively, you can also top the whole cake with whipped cream, then slice it. Without the whipped cream, the cake keeps for up to 5 days in an airtight container on the counter.

The cake is excellent on its own, but for something really special, add whipped cream and dark chocolate shavings.


school. He transferred to West Germany and experienced crisis following the building of the Berlin Wall in the early 60s, also serving in units that patrolled the Soviet border.
