In many places, there were few programs, little fanfare, and not much sense that young women could dream very big through sports. If a school had a girls’ team at all, it often felt more like an extracurricular activity than a serious athletic program. That was just the reality of the times.

Things are very different now.

Today, women’s basketball has become one of the most exciting stories in sports. The athletes are skilled, competitive, and increasingly recognized beyond the court. Names like Sheryl Swoopes, Sue Bird, Diana Taurasi, and Caitlin Clark have helped elevate the women’s game and build a loyal following. While women’s basketball still trails the men’s game when it comes to salaries, endorsements, and media attention, there is no denying the progress that has been made.

And for me, that progress has a very personal face.

It looks like my 12-year-old granddaughter, Emery.

Emery has fallen in love with basketball. Not casually interested in it, not just playing when the season rolls around, but truly committed to it. ## Apologia For King Henry VIII

In a recent conversation with one much younger, but still well along in her adult life, I had a conversation concerning history and historical figures. I made the point that one should generally refrain from judging them and even then, make sure to apply context of time and place in history.

She questioned that and I responded that one cannot, for example, judge Thomas Jefferson for owning slaves since in his time and place that was common and rarely questioned.

Surely there were those who were against slavery, she replied. Doesn't that make people in the 1700s able to be judged on that?

Yes, I said, Adam Smith, who in 1776 laid out the first ideals of free market capitalism also attacked slavery in moral terms. He is, however, an outlier for his times, a rarity. Similarly, the totalitarian murderousness of Hitler, Stalin, and Mao, for example, was an outlier for their time and place. One can judge their evil because it was uncommon and not socially normal in their time and place.

The best way to illustrate the proper way to conduct history lies in breaking down the life and actions of a person that almost invariably gets judged harshly and not for no reason either.

King Henry VIII took the reigns of English royal power in 1509 and held them until 1547.

The turn of the century had come with the death of Pope Alexander VI and the end of the corrupt Borgia power over the Papacy. Portugal, then Spain, had transformed their former European backwater status into colonial powers amassing wealth in the first case from spices, the second via gold and silver.

Henry was never expected to take the throne of England. His elder brother Arthur had been prepared for that role, complete with marriage to Catherine of Aragon, a daughter of the newly rich Spanish royal house. Arthur passed, then too their father King Henry VII.

At the age of 18, now Henry VIII, the new king audaciously proposed to marry what the Roman Catholic Church still considered kin too close to wed, even with her first husband dead. He shored up his Catholic credentials by supporting the Papacy with vehemence in a time when division, then corruption, put that institution at its lowest ebb of influence.

Pope Julius II, an honest and skilled warrior, neither corrupt nor tremendously kind and compassionate, granted a dispensation to Henry to break the rules and marry his sister-in-law. The King got permission after stating that his brother had never consummated the marriage, either, an unpleasant fact or lie to share about one's brother in front of the civilized world. The lack of consummation meant that the marriage was never, in the culture of the day, finalized.

That meant Henry VIII could marry Catherine without it being called incest.

## THIS WEEK IN West Virginia History

Charleston WV — The following events happened on these dates in West Virginia history. To read more, go to e-WV: The West Virginia Encyclopedia at [www.wvencyclopedia.org](http://www.wvencyclopedia.org).

**April 15, 1872:** Peter Godwin Van Winkle died in Parkersburg. Van Winkle was a member of the Governor's Council of the Reorganized Government of Virginia, 1861-63, under Gov. Francis Pierpont. On August 4, 1863, Van Winkle was elected as one of West Virginia's first two U.S. senators.

**April 16, 1829:** Jacob Beeson Jackson was born in Parkersburg. In 1881, he became West Virginia's sixth governor.

**April 16, 1894:** Leonard Riggleman was born in a Randolph County cabin. As president of Morris Harvey College (now University of Charleston), he moved the school to Charleston in 1935 and led the college to accreditation in 1958.

**April 16, 1923:** Arch Moore was born in Moundsville. He was the first governor in 100 years to serve a second term, and he returned later for a third. He also was the second former governor to serve federal prison time.

**April 17, 1827:** Outdoorsman William "Squirrelly Bill" Carpenter was born on the Elk River near the mouth of Laurel Creek, Braxton County. Carpenter guided prominent West Virginians, including Gov. MacCorkle, through the wonders of the Elk Valley.

**April 17, 1861:** Delegates to a special convention in Richmond voted for Virginia to secede from the Union, subject to approval by a public referendum. This decision also set in motion the process that would lead to the creation of West Virginia.

**April 17, 1871:** West Virginians approved the Flick Amendment, restoring voting rights to former Confederates. Although the amendment also applied to formerly enslaved people, they had already been granted suffrage under the Fifteenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution.

**April 17, 1924:** A fire destroyed much of downtown Franklin, the Pendleton County seat.

**April 17, 1972:** Actress Jennifer Garner was born in Houston, Texas. Growing up in Charleston, she appeared in theater and ballet productions before becoming a television and film star.

**April 18, 1756:** The largest battle fought in Virginia during the French and Indian War occurred at Fort Edwards in Hampshire County.

**April 18, 1861:** At the start of the Civil War, retreating U.S. troops set fire to the national armory and arsenal at Harpers Ferry to prevent them from falling into Confederate hands. Virginia militia extinguished the flames, salvaged much of the weapon-making equipment and sent it south before ultimately destroying the site in June 1861.

**April 18, 1912:** The Paint Creek-Cabin Creek Strike of 1912-13 began in Kanawha County when coal operators rejected union workers' demands for higher wages. The ensuing strike became one of the most dramatic and violent episodes in the early 20th-century labor struggles in southern West Virginia, collectively known as the Mine Wars.

**April 19, 1896:** Writer Melville Davisson Post was born in Harrison County. His best-known works are the Randolph Mason series, published in three volumes, and the more successful collection, Uncle Abner: Master of Mysteries.

**April 19, 1902:** Author Jean Lee Latham was born in Buckhannon. She wrote a number of children's books, including Carry On, Mr. Bowditch, which won the 1956 Newbery Award.

**April 20, 1823:** General Jesse Lee Reno was born in Wheeling. He graduated from West Point in 1846, with another cadet from western Virginia, Thomas J. Jackson, later known as "Stonewall." Reno was the highest-ranking officer from present West Virginia killed in the Civil War.

**April 20, 1863:** President Lincoln issued a proclamation that in 60 days, West Virginia would become a state. This occasion was marked 100 years later during the state's Centennial celebration with a special ceremonial session of the West Virginia legislature on April 20, 1963, in Wheeling.

**April 20, 1909:** Fiddler Melvin Wine was born near Burnsville, Braxton County. A favorite of old-time music enthusiasts nationally, he was chosen as a National Heritage Fellow in 1991 by the National Endowment for the Arts, the highest recognition given to a folk artist in the United States.

**April 20, 1939:** Poet Irene McKinney was born in Belington, Barbour County. Governor Gaston Caperton appointed her state poet laureate in 1993, and she served in that capacity until her death in 2012.

**April 21, 1908:** Musician Phoeba Cottrell Parsons was born in Calhoun County. Parsons's traditional clawhammer banjo style, unaccompanied ballad singing, riddles and storytelling have influenced countless numbers of younger musicians.

**April 21, 1936:** President Franklin Roosevelt established the Jefferson National Forest. The West Virginia portion of this forest includes about 19,000 acres in Monroe County.

As a grandfather, that is a wonderful thing to watch. What pleases me most is not just that Emery is developing as a player. It is that she has found something that challenges her, excites her, and gives her purpose. In a world where young people are surrounded by distractions, there is something special about seeing a child become passionate about something that demands discipline, teamwork, sacrifice, and resilience. Basketball is doing more than teaching her how to shoot, defend, or run the floor. It is teaching her

how to work. It is teaching her how to compete. It is teaching her how to handle success and disappointment. Those lessons will matter long after the games are over. And thankfully, she seems to be handling it all with balance. She is keeping her grades up, enjoying her childhood, and still finding joy in the process. That may be the best part of all. Sports should help shape a child, not overwhelm one. So far, basketball appears to be giving Emery exactly what you would hope, confidence, friendships, discipline, and something to

strive for. Watching the Women’s Final Four reminded me that the growth of women’s basketball is not just about television ratings, packed arenas, or famous names. It is also about the thousands of young girls across this country who now see possibilities that earlier generations could hardly imagine. That includes one young girl in our family. And for this grandfather, that makes the rise of women’s basketball feel like more than a sports story. It feels like progress.

One must remember that love and romance was generally foreign to royal and aristocratic classes. Marriages took place to cement alliances or deals. Much of the love poetry of centuries leading up to 1500 revolved around illicit romances conducted from unloving marriages. “The young King of eighteen,” wrote historian G. M. Trevelyan, “exceeded the ordinary run of his subjects in body and in brain.” He had intelligence, physical strength and health, and a drive to stabilize an England still badly damaged and trying to recover from wars stretching back into the 1300s. He cemented relations with the Pope and received the title “Defender of the Faith” for writing against the movement of Martin Luther.

Henry VIII also enjoyed and relied upon the company of learned men and stocked his Court with people who, at first, were more learned and experienced than the King.

Here comes the important part, the reason why many find Henry irredeemable as a historical figure.

As time passed the King endeavored to do his primary duty, which was to reproduce. Trying and trying produced a single healthy and intellectually capable daughter, Mary. No son emerged to inherit the throne. Henry VIII soon faced a serious problem, He had one daughter and a wife many years his elder whose childrearing years would soon conclude.

And they did conclude. The King would go to every extreme to have his son and heir. He could not get a divorce or an annulment from the previously accommodating Papacy because the Lutheran challenge had grown into open conflict. Roman Catholic doctrine does not allow for divorce, so Henry VIII went to Parliament and got it to vote to support severance from Rome.

Parliament allowed for the creation of the Church of England with the royal “Defender of the Faith” as its head instead of the Pope. The nation seized all Church property as well, which enriched the Crown immeasurably.

Henry VIII, as most in his time did, erroneously believed that mothers determined the sex of their children. He married a series of women in an effort to obtain his male heir, divorcing and also

executing some as he labored to have a healthy son. From those marriages, he was blessed with a daughter Elizabeth and a weak, not very bright young man who inherited the throne from Henry and promptly died.

The strong-willed Mary took the throne, followed shortly after by the brilliant and cunning Elizabeth I. Every bit the monarch Henry dreamed of producing, save the gender, Elizabeth transformed a small and weak nation into a power ready to expand its influence globally through trade and a growing navy.

From the modern eyes, Henry VIII appears a horrific murderer, a lunatic in pursuit of a goal in itself that seems beyond the pale. Murder followed by apparent misogyny with the King overturning his realm and society itself to get his male heir.

Many judge harshly, or comedically, but few try to explore why the King pursued a male heir so doggedly.

First one should ask why the King felt his realm would not accept a Queen as its ruler.

Henry VII has faded mostly from history. He preceded VIII as king and dedicated his work to quiet and sound administration. Prior to him, however, had come the powerfully destructive Wars of the Roses. England had opened the Hundred Years War in the 1300s whilst controlling much of what is now France. Joan of Arc helped to turn the tide and the English were mostly evicted from the Continent at wars’ end.

The last quarter-century of the 1400s saw England in the grip of a conflict known as the Wars of the Roses. From the York and Lancaster family came claimants to an open throne. They and their allies waged something between a civil war and a massive family feud. Commoners mostly stood aside as royals and aristocracy slaughtered each other until the final victory at Bosworth field.

He, known first as the Earl of Richmond, then Henry VII, the patriarch of the Tudor family thus ascended the throne. Trevelyan described him as “cautious and thrifty to a fault” and that “after Bosworth, England wanted, not more adventures in shining armor but peace, retrenchment, and above all, the enforcement of order.

Henry VIII was not thrifty and not cautious, but he did inherit his father’s dedication to establishing

the throne and nation in as secure of ground as possible.

A woman had not held a throne in the land known as England since well before it was England. Rome had conquered Celtic Britain around 40 AD, but allowed for local governance over two more decades. Then the King the Romans had suffered to remain in place passed away. Roman administrators seized complete control and deprived leading landowners of their property.

Roman historians noted that her forces slaughtered the Roman Ninth Legion and massacred 70,000 of the conquerors and their allies. While that seems to be a sound example from which Henry VIII could draw on female leadership, one must remember that she lived 1,500 years before the King. He may have only been dimly aware of her existence. Most of his subjects outside of Wales likely had little or no knowledge of her either.

This condition left Henry VIII with a reasonable fear and a powerful impetus to fulfil what he saw as his duty to the Crown, his family, and England itself. He had solid reason to fear what would come of England should he leave her in the care of a female monarch. One can debate and discuss if the King did the right thing in response to his reasonable fears or not. One cannot simply dismiss him as mentally ill or imbalanced because the King had a powerful native intelligence and proceeded from it to action.

Serious historians will disagree with each other on various points. The point is that few things take place in history without reasons that can be explained if people will but hear them. Whether or not one changes their mind about this King is immaterial, one cannot evaluate without understanding.

And that is what history is about. The point is not figuring out whether Henry VIII is a “good guy” or a “bad guy,” then finding ways to use him to make a modern political point. That is not history. History is the pursuit of understanding. That may take us to dark places and difficult to untangle questions, but it is much better to understand (in most cases) historical figures, or nations for that matter, rather than rush to condemn based merely on sensibilities held by an elite minority of minds today and no other aspects of context and culture.

## LUCAS to offer lung cancer screening in Craigsville, Jane Lew, West Milford, and Clarksburg

MORGANTOWN, W.Va. – LUCAS, a first of its kind, state-of-the-art mobile lung cancer screening unit, will visit Nicholas, Lewis, and Harrison counties offering low-dose computed tomography (LDCT) scans.

A service of WVU Medicine-WVU Hospitals and the WVU Cancer Institute, LUCAS will be at:

- Camden Family Health of Craigsville from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on May 5. For an appointment, call 304-226-5725.
- Family Medical Clinic of Jane Lew from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on May 6. For an appointment, call 304-884-7880.
- Community Care of West Milford from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on May 7. For an appointment, call 304-745-4568.
- Community Care of Clarksburg from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on May 8. For an appointment, call 304-623-6330, ext. 1712.

The lung cancer screenings are billed to private insurance, Medicaid, or Medicare. Uninsured patients living in West Virginia who meet screening criteria can receive their lung cancer screening on LUCAS through the generosity of grant funding

and donations. A physician’s order and prior authorization from insurance are required to get screened. Appointments must be made 14 or more days in advance of the visit to allow time for insurance pre-authorizations.

LUCAS, an acronym for Lung Cancer Screening, builds upon the success and infrastructure established by Bonnie’s Bus. In West Virginia, more people die of lung cancer than colorectal, prostate, and breast cancer combined. LUCAS travels throughout West Virginia, especially in rural parts of the state with limited or no access to lung cancer screening.

Similar to mammography, regular lung cancer screening can detect cancer early, when it is easier to treat and cure. Both units are part of the WVU Cancer Institute Mobile Cancer Screening Program and work in collaboration with a statewide partnership of clinicians, public health professionals, and other community leaders to reduce the number of deaths from breast and lung cancer in West Virginia.

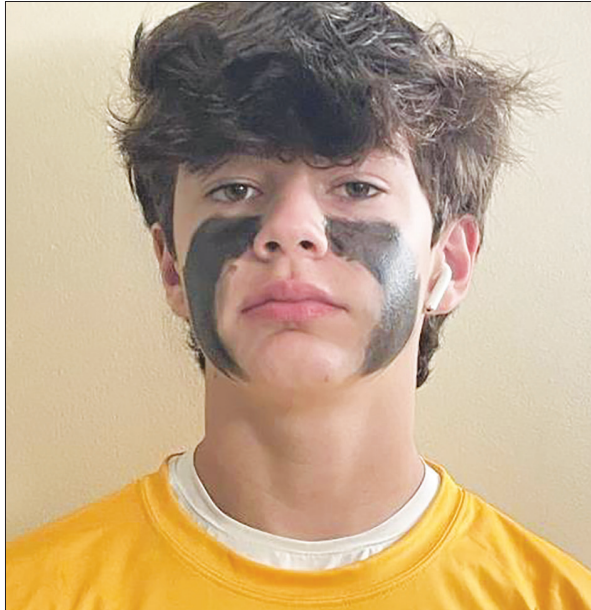
Maxx didn't have anything else to prove, just making it back to the diamond showed his resolve. It tells us all everything we need to know about this fearless young man.

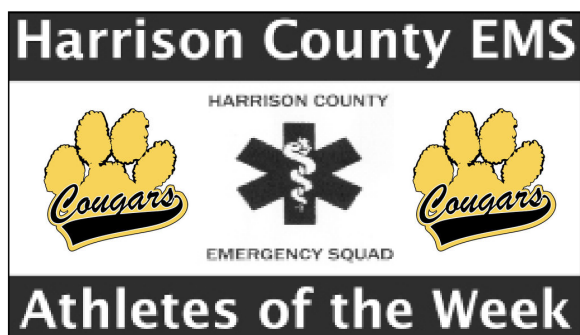
Robert C. Byrd is off to a solid start, defeating Bridgeport last week eight to four. It was their first win over the Indians since 2021.

# Fairmont State University Athletics Falcons Take Twinbill Against Point Park Softball

Pittsburgh, Pa. — Fairmont State University (18-6, 8-0 MEC) swept Point Park University (7-16, 2-6 MEC) with a decisive 9-1 victory in game one, followed by a 4-1 win in game two on Monday at Fairhaven Park.

**Game 1:** Fairmont State 9, Point Park 1 (5 Inn.) In game one, Fairmont State opened the scoring in the second inning with a powerful offensive display, racking up five runs. Jaylin McGill started the rally with a single up the middle, followed by a walk to Paige Matteson. Abbie Keilhoz then delivered a double to center field, driving in both McGill and Matteson. Bella Hess walked, stole second, and advanced on a wild pitch, setting up Avery Townsend to reach on a fielder's choice that allowed Keilhoz to score.

Emma Paul capped the inning with a single to center, bringing in Townsend and Hess, giving the Falcons a commanding 5-0 lead after two innings. The scoring continued for Fairmont State in the third inning as Alexa Foresha singled, and walks to Matteson and Nogay loaded the bases. Hess walked, scoring Foresha, which brought the score to 6-1 by the end of the inning.

The Falcons maintained their momentum in the fifth, with McGill doubling down the left field line. After a single by Matteson, Keilhoz doubled again, scoring McGill, and Hess followed with a double of her own, bringing in both Matteson and Keilhoz. The inning concluded with Fairmont State holding a commanding 9-1 lead. Point Park managed a lead-off double in the

bottom of the fifth but could not capitalize, as the Falcons closed out the game with an eight-run margin. Delaney Haller pitched 4 innings, allowing 6 hits and 1 earned run while striking out 1 batter. Liz Alsop contributed 1 inning in relief, allowing just 1 hit through 4 batters faced, with no earned runs or walks. Hess drove in three runs with a double and added a stolen base. Keilhoz scored two runs, hitting two doubles and driving in three runs. McGill added two runs and two hits, including a double, and recorded a stolen base. Paul finished with two hits, including a double, and drove in two runs.

**Game 2:** Fairmont State 4, Point Park 1 In game two, Fairmont State struck first in the first inning when Bella Hess singled down the left-field line, advancing on a single by Avery Townsend. Both Hess and Emma Paul, who reached on a fielder's choice, scored when Breonna Marietta singled up the middle, giving the Falcons a 2-0 lead.

The Falcons extended their lead to 3-0 in the second inning, with Hess singling again and being brought home by a single from Paul. In the fourth inning, Hess continued her impressive performance, singling and stealing both second and third bases before scoring on Paul's double to left field. Point Park managed to respond with a run in the bottom half, bringing the score to 4-1 in favor of the Falcons. However, neither team scored further, and the game concluded with Fairmont State securing the victory. Caitlin Morey delivered a stellar complete game



performance for the Falcons in game two, pitching 7 innings while allowing just one earned run.

She faced 29 batters, striking out four and walking three, while giving up five hits. Bella Hess scored three runs, collected four hits, and stole two bases. Avery Townsend added three hits while Emma Paul recorded two RBIs with two hits and scored once. Fairmont State returns to Duvall-Rosier Field on Friday, April 3 to face Wheeling University. Doubleheader is set to start at 1:00 p.m.

# The Literary Journey of Nicole Yurcaba That Extends From the Highlands of Western Ukraine to the Mountains of West Virginia

“Let us not dare to attempt the definition of poetry, nor answer the question what it is,” wrote Walt Whitman on the topic of his vocation. The Philadelphia native combined great patriotic pride, simple and elegant prose, and a sometimes controversial sensuality to his globally-respected work.

For poems can comfort and inspire, or they can call out the gap between what is and what ought to be, or what is and what should never be. Something of all of this emerges in the work of Ukrainian-American poet Nicole Yurcaba, Resident of West Virginia – Citizen of the World.

Yurcaba has published two collections of poetry, the first relating back to the singular event that created a dividing line of “before” and “after,” the “special operation” of the Russian armed forces that has pounded away at her country’s territory and has threatened its very sovereignty ever since.

She shared that one of her published collections “was one poem written for every day of the war.” In these versus are not “a fiery gospel, writ in burnished rows of steel,” but the pain of a stranger in a strange land, struggling with a new place, a different culture, and people who even when expressing compassion do not truly understand her country’s story. All the while continually processing for years the ever-changing face of the struggle that continues in Ukraine.

“I come from a Ukraine family,” Yucaba explained, “but I have lived in Hardy County for many years.

Few Americans have a grasp on Ukraine’s history. The Primary Chronicle shares its version of its origins, when the people in and around the region of Kyiv (the Russian language version of the name is Kiev) declared “our land is great and rich, but there is no order in it.” They prevailed on three Varangian (Viking) brothers to organize their land and rule justly over it. The Kyivan Rus, as it was known, is the cradle of the later three nations of Ukraine, Russia, and Belorussia.

Mongols sent by Kublai Khan and his successors annihilated the Kyivan Rus just as it had established civilization standards well ahead of that time’s Anglo-Saxon England or Charlemagne’s Holy Roman Empire. A papal ambassador reported a few years later of fields filled with the skulls of their victims and bemoaned the loss of the city’s famously elegant churches and other structures.

Russia tried to erase the nationalist aspects of Ukraine during its imperial period ending in 1917, imposing its own language and mores to the point that the native language disappeared from use. The late 1800s saw academic interest worldwide in the preservation and promotion of culture, leading to a revival of the use of the Ukrainian language and the restoration of that nation’s literature and national feeling.

Ukraine had a brief period of independence as a German satellite in the closing years of World War I. The Russian-dominated Soviet Union never forgot what it saw as perfidy and Josef Stalin reserved a special punishment for the dedicated and hard-working prosperous peasantry of Ukraine. Take their land, take their farms, force them to work as near-serfs on land that Imperial Russia had grudgingly given when they were freed in 1866. The farmers resolved to destroy all they had to keep it from Stalin’s hands, ate what they could of their crops and livestock, and burned the rest.

Stalin’s revenge killed tens of millions. Some Ukrainians joined the Germans when they invaded in 1941, only to see National Socialist hatreds visited on them as eagerly as against Russians and Jews. Ukraine would not taste freedom again until 1991 when it, Russia, and Belorussia seceded from the Soviet Union and became independent states.

Vladimir Putin, likely driven in part by the quickly shrinking population of Russia, had seized the Crimea in 2015, then launched the full-scale attack on the nation in 2022.

As the question of more or less U.S. involvement dominated American politics, the issue devolved into a tennis ball batted back and forth. Not everyone understood the toll on Ukrainians, even those living in the United States. Sometimes, comments made on social media and in person took her aback.

“You as West Virginians, if you had family here for 150, 200 years, you know what this is about,” Yorcuba explained. “Your motto is Mountaineers Are Always Free. That’s what Ukraine wants. We’ve always been colonized by Russians.” Another point of comparison, especially for those in Hardy County, lies in the historical memory of the Confederate States, from Union Army Major General Phil Sheridan’s using starvation as a weapon in the nearby Shenandoah Valley to the heroic raid of McNeill’s Rangers.

Yet the understanding did not come as often as hoped. “We felt an otherness,” shared Yorcuba, “a grief about the war socially because of political ruptures, a lot of friendships and a lot of relationships ended.”

“The most irritating thing is when people say Ukrainians are the same as Russians,” she shared, echoing one of the greatest complaints of West Virginians since 1863. The very identity of the place gets erased in so many minds because of the very limited knowledge of the area’s existence as a separate place and culture.

Whitman wrote “The poetic area is very spacious – has so many mansions – has room for all . . . literature in its deepest sense defies measurement, rules, standards; all genius defies the rules.”

“The Pale Goth” released in 2023 and reveals an artist working with not only words, but also how a reader might perceive them on the page. It shares pieces of life from the perspective of multiple women, including the author. Like Sergio Leone’s most famous Westerns, one never hears the name of the protagonist.

A pair of poems, separated by a few others in the work, are entitled My Depression Side A and My Depression Side B. Each takes a song already performed and recorded and puts down how each affects the first person subject of the poem. Yurcaba explained that while some of the first person characters represent her personal experience, others come from the stories of the lives of others.

The Depression poems seem intensely personal. Part of the first, entitled Track 3 – The Cure “Strange Days” offers a series of words, some paired, others individual. They appear in seemingly random spacing on the page and their vague nature to the reader all but confirms how personal these words are to the writer and whoever’s story she is relating here.

Another such poem, “Dead Ringer” spaces words describing a falling, suffering descent towards death, with each word impressing more and more the torment of the subject.

Most of the poems, however, illustrate the life and travails of “the Pale Goth,” the woman with no name. “The Pale Goth” remembers lovers, faces off with a state trooper in a convenience store, and confronts those who once tormented her in high school at the 10-year reunion.

“The great idea – that, O my brethren, that is the mission of poets,” trumpeted Whitman.

Yurcaba’s second book establishes a general theme of a Ukrainian-American navigating these unfamiliar and shifting social landscapes as war rages. Her journey of life and work took her to Europe, to New Jersey, and often to Virginia, but never away from the ongoing war.

“We turned to poetry as a means of expression,” said Yurcaba, who explained further that such works create “unity for the diaspora (spread of a national people outside of their homeland) in community with . . . “the enlisted serving on the front lines.”

Yurcaba’s next work would combine the intensely personal revelations from the lives of women with the intensely personal trauma felt by those who call Ukraine home. It serves the now as an explanation of how Ukrainian-Americans deal daily with the fears of war at home and discontent with how others see and



also use that conflict. Whitman explained that, “The words of true poems are the general light and dark.”

Her 2026 publication, Hutsulka, brings a different tone starting with the contrast in title names. The title of the 2026 work refers to a traditional dance performed by large groups in celebration of holidays or happy events, such as weddings. Those participating often wear beautiful bright red and white traditional clothing as a celebration of community and life itself.

“Ode to a Man Who Is the Wolf About Which He Warns” combines the dichotomy of a woman dealing with the typical irritations and occasional indignities of life with that of a patriotic person always in worry over her country. The “man who quotes Kirkegaard” with a taste for the finest in whiskeys also crassly ogles models on social media in front of the poet who he seeks to impress.

After her poetic stream of consciousness moves to “war in my homeland. I haven’t heard from my cousin serving in the army in two days,” it returns to the grandiloquent who alternates soothing reassurances with vulgar discussions of sexual positions. The poem reflects accurately how the continuing suffering halfway around the world intersperses with everyday life.

Others poems lash out at those who think they understand or use apparent empathy to bring attention to themselves. These include “Ode to a U.S. Army Special Forces Soldier Educating Me About My Homeland’s Literature” and also “Ode to a German Rock Star Who Flies My Homeland’s Flag During Rock Concerts.”

Then comes the struggle when even those with whom the poetic subject shares the most intimate ties object to her patriotism. “I wonder how, when you hate my homeland so much you can even tolerate me” reads one line. The subject speculates “perhaps you fantasize about strangling me while I sleep beside you, our cats nestled between us.”

“But the final test of poems, or any character, or work, remains: Has it help’d any human soul?” asked Whitman.

Yurcaba’s works nobly help human souls on two different tracks. They give a deep and personal understanding of a woman who presents to the world in unconventional ways, maintaining her dignity in the face of a world that mostly rejects those expressions. They also reveal the mindset of a people whose agony will continue as long as the drones fly, the artillery fires, and a single soldier in a Russian uniform remains free in their land.

Human souls helped the most, however, are those who live these truths and fears daily. Poems help the human soul in the most fundamental fashion by telling each soul “You are not alone. Someone else has endured as you have.”

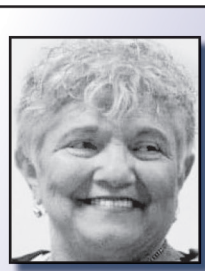

On his list is also overseeing the properties of the church which is the priests residence, the nuns residence, and the church center which houses the offices and a social hall for gatherings.

If this seems a tremendous task, we must not forget he must oversee the finances of the church and oversee his staff. He has a staff of an assistant, two nuns, and several office assistants. At any time you may see his

assistant doing mass or the nuns visiting the hospitals. His assistants will prepare financial statements. And last but not least he has a host of volunteers who head up committees. For socials, who prepare bereavement dinners, who oversee the cleaning of the church, who assist with church repairs and the list goes on and on.

Father Casey has certainly earned his retirement, we will miss him and we wish him well. We welcome our new priest and pledge our support to him.

## MonPower rate reduction approved

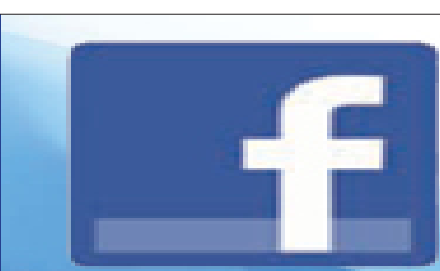
CHARLESTON – Customers of Monongahela Power Co. and The Potomac Edison Co. should see a decrease in rates after the Public Service Commission of West Virginia approved a reduction in charges for the companies' vegetation management control program.

"Under the companies' proposal, an average residential customer using 1,000 kilowatt-hours per month would see a decrease of \$0.23 per month, or

0.17 percent" the order said. The average monthly bill would total \$137.43. The decreased rates were effective immediately.

The order, which results from a company filing last August 29, reconciles charges with costs.
