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


1982 Project gets \$1,000,000 for water work on Avalon campus

 The Avalon campus of the 1982 Foundation got a major boost in completing some major work on its water system when the state awarded it a \$1,000,000 grant.
 “We are truly grateful for the additional \$1,000,000 from the state of West Virginia,” said Crystal Mersh of the 1982 Foundation. “We have now received \$2,000,000 from the WVWDA for economic development in north central West Virginia. We wish to express our thanks to Governor (Jim) Justice for believing in our people and our vision.”
 Gov. Justice announced the West Virginia Water Development Authority (WDA) has approved funding for 24 Economic Enhancement Grant Fund projects totaling \$67,425,807.
 In April 2022, Gov. Justice called a special session to fund the Economic Enhancement Grant Fund, at the time securing an initial amount of \$250 million.
 Since then, the program has seen exceptional success, and the WDA has approved EEGF projects worth \$594 million, which has resulted in \$2.3 billion of projects getting across the finish line. Over 614,000 West Virginians have been affected by these projects, which have touched every corner of the state.
 The latest water and sewer projects approved by the Water Development Authority include:
 City of Ravenswood — Jackson County
 The City of Ravenswood was awarded a \$32,375,000 WDA EEGF grant to construct a new wastewater treatment plant. The total project cost is \$65,000,000.
 City of Milton — Cabell County
 The City of Milton has received a \$1,000,000 WDA EEGF grant for waterline replacement along Route 60 and the construction of a water storage tank at the east tank site. The total project cost is \$4,800,000.
 Town of Ansted — Fayette County
 The Town of Ansted has secured a \$4,753,000 WDA EEGF grant to upgrade its wastewater treatment plant. The total project cost is \$13,360,000.
 Mason County Public Sewer District — Mason County
 The Mason County Public Sewer District was awarded a \$2,000,000 WDA EEGF grant to provide sanitary sewer service to 256 new customers in the Apple Grove, Mercers Bottom, and Ashton areas. The total project cost is \$25,000,000.
 City of Piedmont — Mineral County
 The City of Piedmont has received a \$775,000 WDA EEGF grant to develop a groundwater well that will serve as its primary water source. The total project

cost is \$1,550,000.
 City of Thomas — Tucker County
 The City of Thomas has secured a \$1,030,000 WDA EEGF grant to install a pre-treatment system at their water treatment plant. The total project cost is \$1,530,000.
 City of Spencer — Roane County
 The City of Spencer was awarded a \$305,000 WDA EEGF grant for sewer plant improvements. The total project cost is \$3,071,352.50.
 Greater Harrison Public Service District — Harrison County
 The Greater Harrison Public Service District has received a \$2,504,000 WDA EEGF grant to extend service to 747 new customers in the country club, Laurel Park, and Route 73 areas. The total project cost is \$26,036,832.
 Huttonsville Public Service District — Randolph County
 The Huttonsville Public Service District has secured \$1,800,000 WDA EEGF to upgrade its current wastewater treatment plant. The total project cost is \$3,989,731.50.
 Southern Jackson Public Service District — Jackson County
 Southern Jackson Public Service District was awarded a \$720,000 WDA EEGF grant to extend water service to 13 new customers in the Belgrove area. The total project cost is \$720,000.
 Southern Jackson Public Service District — Jackson County
 Southern Jackson Public Service District has received a \$340,000 WDA EEGF grant to extend water service to five new customers on New Stone Ridge Road. The total project cost is \$340,000.
 Southern Jackson Public Service District — Jackson County
 Southern Jackson Public Service District has secured an additional \$1,670,000 WDA EEGF grant to further extend water service to 22 new customers along Statts Mill Road. The total project cost is \$1,670,000.

 The amazing photos taken by Jerry Mann show the level of fire that left Lisa without a business and tenant Angela Miller without a home just a few days before Christmas. Neither renter had insurance and would likely appreciate any help that the community could offer. Another apartment was rented by Bonnie Brown, who passed away last week.
 Building owner Kevin Postalwait was very saddened that he cannot rebuild the unit due to it being in the flood plain. This is another business loss for the Town of Grantsville as well as lost revenue for the water, sewer and taxes.
 The cause of the fire is unknown.

RUFFLING SOME BUFFALO FEATHERS: Marshall was invited to play Army in the Independence Bowl at Shreveport, La., but a funny thing happened on the way to the game -- Marshall fell apart.

Charles Huff quit as the Thundering Herd football coach to take the head coaching position at Southern Miss.

And an exodus of football players began.

As it stands, Marshall has 29 players in the NCAA transfer portal, including all three of its quarterbacks. In addition to players in the transfer portal, defensive end Mike Green, who led the NCAA in sacks this season, has entered the NFL Draft and would not have played in the game.

Marshall quickly moved to hire former N.C. State defensive coordinator Tony Gibson as Huff's replacement, but Gibson will not begin his job until football begins in the spring semester.

Down over two dozen players and various staffers, Marshall was unable to field a team capable of competing at a high level in the Independence Bowl. Thus, they will not be playing in the game.

Marshall was replaced by the Louisiana Tech Bulldogs which will face Army in the Independence Bowl. Louisiana Tech finished the season with a 5-7 record and was not initially bowl eligible.

Following the withdrawal, I posted on a Marshall web site that I would see the

folks who caused this mess - the former coaching staff and the players who left in hell before I would have thrown in the towel.

I also said Marshall did not quit when an airplane crash killed 75 people including most of the football team and staff back on Nov. 14, 1970.

I continued by saying quitting was an affront to the '75' and finished by saying "We were ... Marshall."

Dec. 26, 1917: Instrument maker Harold M. Hayslett was born in Putnam County.

Hayslett's violins, violas and cellos have received awards for tone and workmanship, and are cherished by collectors and players alike.

Dec. 27, 1797: The county seat of Ohio County was moved from West Liberty to Wheeling.



Dec. 27, 1923: Businessman and Point Pleasant native Michael Owens, who revolutionized the glass industry through automation, died at age 64.



Dec. 28, 1879: Brigadier General Billy Mitchell was born in France. As chief of the Army Air Service, Mitchell ordered aircraft of the 88th Squadron to perform reconnaissance during the 1921 Miners' March on Logan.

Dec. 28, 1978: The last trains ran on the Greenbrier Division, a branch line of the Chesapeake & Ohio Railway. Unlike most C&O branches in West Virginia, the Greenbrier Division was not a coal-hauling line but served the valley's timber industry.

Dec. 29, 1861: Confederate soldiers burned most of downtown Sutton. The town slowly rebuilt but remained small until the local timber industry boomed in the 1890 to 1920 period.



Dec. 29, 1928: Humorist and political cartoonist James Frederick Dent was born in Charleston. His talent for turning daily events into delightful anecdotes gained him national fame. Reader's Digest reprinted 194 items from his columns, and radio commentator Paul Harvey often used his work.



Dec. 29, 1970: John Denver and two friends completed the song "Take Me Home, Country Roads." Denver performed "Country Roads" in West Virginia on several occasions, notably for the opening of the new Mountaineer Stadium in Morgantown in 1980.

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Dec. 30, 1901: McKendree Hospital started providing medical care in rural Fayette County. It was one of three hospitals established by the state in the fast-growing coalfields.

Dec. 30, 1917: The temperature in Lewisburg dropped to 37 degrees below zero. It is the coldest official temperature on record for the state.

Dec. 31, 1939: Larry Combs, one of the world's leading orchestral clarinetists, was born in South Charleston. He started studying woodwinds at age 10 and was principal clarinetist for the Charleston (now West Virginia) Symphony Orchestra at age 16. He later served in the same role for symphonies in Montreal and Chicago and was inducted into the West Virginia Music Hall of Fame in 2009.

Dec. 31, 2007: Sara Jane Moore was released from prison after serving 32 years for trying to kill President Ford. Moore grew up in Charleston and later moved to California,

where she joined left-wing groups and became an FBI informant. She spent part of her incarceration at the Federal Prison Camp in Alderson.



Jan. 1, 1888: In one of the most violent episodes of the Hatfield-McCoy Feud, Jim Vance, uncle to "Devil Anse" Hatfield, led an arson attack on the McCoy family cabin. Two of Randall McCoy's children were killed, and his wife was beaten.

Jan. 1, 1953: Country music legend Hank Wil-



liams was found dead in his car in Oak Hill, Fayette County. He had been scheduled to perform in Charleston the previous night, but the concert was canceled due to bad weather.




