
March 28 - An Easter Egg Hunt was held on the courthouse lawn.

Two killed, two wounded in Saturday Calhoun shooting

On Saturday, Dec. 28, 2024, at approximately 8:28 am, Trooper C. A. Lane and Trooper L. E. Whitt were advised of a shooting incident off of Pine Creek Road near Grantsville by the Calhoun County Emergency Operations Center.

Calhoun County Sheriff Graham Knight was the first law enforcement officer on scene. He arrived at approximately 8:59 am and found 51-year-old Jodee Tribioli of Grantsville and 71-year-old Carole Heagy of Mount Gretna, Pa., deceased from apparent gunshot wounds.

Two additional victims, 55-year-old Steve Tribioli of Grantsville and 66-year-old Claude Heagy of Mount Gretna, Pa., had also suffered gunshot wounds but were

Upon Trooper Lane and Trooper Whitt's arrival Sheriff Knight turned the investigation over to the West Virginia State Police. Investigators were able to identify 28-year-old, Noah Richard Tribioli, of Columbia, Pa., as a suspect. Investigators also said Noah Tribioli was Steve Tribioli's son.

A statewide Be On the Look Out "BOLO" was put out by the West Virginia State

Police- South Charleston Communications Section for Noah Tribioli and his ve-

Noah Tribioli was located and apprehended by Senior Trooper L. L. Cox near Hico, in Fayette County.

WVSP Crime Scene units responded to the scene of this incident by assisting in the processing of the crime scene. Additional WVSP Crime Scene units responded to process Noah Tribioli's vehicle.

Noah Tribioli was arrested and arraigned on two (2) counts of first-degree murder, two (2) counts of attempted first degree murder, two (2) counts of malicious wounding, and two (2) counts of attempt to commit a felony. He was remanded to the Southern Regional Jail without bond.

Both male victims were transported to Minnie Hamilton Health System in Grantsville and then transferred to Charleston Area Medical Center- General Division to undergo surgery for their injuries. Steve Tribioli is listed as being in critical condition. Claude Heagy is listed as being in stable condition.

The status of this investigation remains active and ongoing.

Gov. Justice orders U.S. and State flags to be flown at half-staff in honor and commemoration of **President Jimmy Carter**

Gov. Jim Justice issued the following statement today upon learning of the passing of James Earl Carter Jr., the 39th President of the United States.

"President Jimmy Carter faithfully served his country with kindness and compassion. His life was well-lived, and he will be missed by all. Cathy and I send our prayers and condolences to the Carter family and ask all West Virginians to join with us."

In honor and commemoration of President James Earl Carter Jr., Gov. Justice has issued a proclamation ordering that all United States and West Virginia State flags on all State-owned facilities be displayed at half-staff immediately through sunset on Tuesday, January 28, 2025.

Gov. Justice, WV DCR celebrate hiring milestones with 603 graduates in 2024

Gov. NOT IMMUNE TO MURDER: I woke up Saturday morning to a blurb on the internet about a shooting incident on Pine Creek. As the day went of the story was updated with two people being killed and two being injured and a man being on the run. The suspected shooter ended up being caught in Fayette County.

It was a shocking day for Calhoun County because murder is not a common happening here.

But they do happen.

The first murder I remember happened on Jan. 5, 1963, when 53-year-old Irene Wilson was stabbed 52 times in her Nobe home.

No arrest was ever made.

My grandfather George Duskey was a murder victim in 1975.

He was 84 at the time and when four young men decided to rob him of his \$31 military pension he hit one with his cane and they beat him to death before trying to burn him on the cook stove. His murder at Richardson is one of the most brutal murders ever committed in Calhoun County, excluding the decapitation of Peter Sauborne during the Civil War and the 50-plus stab wound murder of Irene Wilson in 1963. So murders have been part of the history of Calhoun County since before the county was part of West Virginia but still a murder triggers a shock wave throughout the county.

And I pray that we are always shocked when it happens.

BRIGHTER DAYS AHEAD: From what I have seen for some of Calhoun County High School's teams brighter days are ahead.

I have watched an extremely young boys' basketball team – they have one senior, and the rest are freshmen and sophomores – grow up before my eyes early in the season.

They will suffer growing pains no doubt, but they will be good sooner than later. Could they be a .500-or-better team this year?

Maybe.

The schedule is pretty tough, but these kids are growing as a team every time they go out.

Another Red Devils team that is improving as the season progresses is the high school wrestling team that recently finished 11th in the massive Fallen Heroes tournament held in Beckley.

There is one senior on the roster, but the younger wrestlers are progressing so fast that some could find themselves on the winners stand at the LKC, regional and state levels.

Here's to better things for our Red Devils.

Jan. 2, 2006: An explosion at the Sago Mine in Upshur County killed 12 men. Federal investigators pointed to a lightning strike as the most likely ignition source for the blast.



Jan. 3, 1856: Musician Lewis Johnson "Uncle Jack" McElwain of Webster County was born. He was the most respected fiddler in central West Virginia during his lifetime. He took part in many fiddle contests, and no one can recall him ever being beaten.



Jan. 3, 1921: The state capitol building in Charleston was destroyed by fire. The so-called Victorian capitol, the second one in Charleston, had opened in 1887. After the fire, a temporary wood-frame building was erected in just 42 days and became known as the "pasteboard capitol." It burned in 1927.



Jan. 4, 1897: Classes began at Montgomery Preparatory School, a state institution established to prepare students for West Virginia University. The school evolved into the West Virginia University Institute of Technology.

Jan. 5, 1810: The Virginia General Assembly recognized 20 acres of land owned by farmer and trader Thomas Buffington at the confluence of the Guyandotte and Ohio rivers as the new village of Guyandotte.

Jan. 6, 1828: Ward Hill Lamon was born in Jefferson County. Lamon was friend, law partner and unofficial bodyguard to President Abraham Lincoln. President Lincoln was assassinated when Lamon was away in Richmond on business.



Jan. 6, 1931: An underground gas explosion killed eight men at the Glen Rogers coal mine in Wyoming County—eight years after another explosion had killed 27 at the same mine.



Jan. 6, 1937: Football coach Lou Holtz was born in Follansbee, Brooke County. At Notre Dame, he won his only national championship after defeating West Virginia University in the 1989 Fiesta Bowl.



Jan. 7, 1910: A fire destroyed everything on Main Street in Bramwell from the train depot to Block Street with the exception of two buildings. The town was quickly rebuilt, creating many of the beautiful Victorian houses that stand today.

Jan. 7, 1955: The Cedar Lakes Conference officially Center opened, though it was not named until 1957. The name was chosen for its two lakes and an abundance of native cedar trees.



Jan. 8, 1866: William Gustavus Conley was born near Kingwood in Preston County. Conley was West Virginia's 18th governor, serving from 1929 to 1933.



Jan. 8, 1919: The West Virginia legislature ratified the U.S. constitution's 18th Amendment in the Senate, 26-0, and in the House, 81-3. West Virginia was the 21st state to ratify it. National prohibition went into effect under the Volstead Act on January 16, 1920.

Jan. 8, 1926: Comedian Soupy Sales was born Milton Supman. Raised in Huntington and graduating from Marshall College (now University), he achieved fame as a
