Part 1

THE PURPOSE OF HUMAN BEINGS and THE DAY OF TEHUTY

The temples tell the story that when the human being was created, we were barbarians, ignorant, no motivation for movement. It was at this time that the God of our ancestors, WSR (OSIRIS) appealed to Gods in the name of humans. Then the Gods asked the humans: "What is your agenda?"

Humans responded: "We want to be like you. We want to replicate your world."

The gods said: "You want to be like us? You are corruptible, we are not. You are dirty, we are pure. You are mortal we are eternal ... but you want to be like us?"

Humans responded: "We have no other ambition than to strive for perfection."

So, the Gods gave humans three things:

- **77 Commandments:** "Here is the list of what you should do and what you should not do. (That's where our notion of good and bad came from - good is what you should do and bad is what you should not do). Every God and Goddess gave a command.

NWT (Mother of the Gods) gave 32 Commandments alone. That day: 19 of TEHUTI of the Sidereal calendar (which corresponds to the 29th of September of the Gregorian calendar) became the biggest celebration for humanity.

- **MEDU NTR** - the language of the Gods - The 77 commandments were written in Medu.

- **M'TAM** (GEOMANCY) - The Gods finally said to the humans: "We will no longer introduce ourselves to you now. However, if you need to contact us to check your spiritual progress, here is a science to use."
