Knowing God by Knowing His Heart, Love, Purpose and Economy

Scripture Reading: Phil. 3:10a; 2 Tim. 1:12; Rom. 12:1-2; John 3:16; Gen. 1:26-27; Eph. 3:8-11; Dan. 4:26, 34-35; Rev. 4:2; 1 Cor. 2:16; Rom. 8:14, 6; 1 Tim. 2:3-4; John 15:10

I. God's heart and God's love—Rom. 12:1; John 3:16; Rom. 5:8; 8:31-39; Eph. 1:4-5; 2:4-5:

- A. We need to see that God's heart is always good towards us, that His heart is a heart of love.
- B. We need to see His compassions in His predestination, in His choosing, in His will, in His incarnation, in His loving death on the cross, in His becoming the life-giving Spirit and His indwelling, and in His sovereign arrangement of the environment for our salvation, growth and transformation.

II. God's purpose and God's economy—Rom, 12:2; Gen. 1:26-27; Eph. 1:9-10; 3:8-11; 2 Tim. 1:9:

- A. God's purpose is to have a corporate man as his expression and representation.
- B. God's economy is His plan, His way, to accomplish His purpose.
- C. Although we have heard so much regarding God's purpose and economy, we need to consider how much these matters actually affect us in our daily living.
- D. We need to speak God's purpose and economy, for by our own speaking the Lord can cause us to see more in a firsthand way.

III. God's sovereignty and God's will—Rom. 12:2; Dan. 4:26, 34-35; Rom 9:19-21; Rev. 4:2:

- A. We need to realize and accept God's sovereignty, thus acknowledging His lordship in our lives.
- B. Then it will be easier for us both to know and say "amen" to the Lord's leading in our lives.
- C. All of us must seek the Lord's will (leading) for our lives personally, however not in a self-centered way, merely seeking the Lord's blessing, but rather in light of God's eternal will (purpose).

IV. God's mind and God's leading—Rom 12:2; 1 Cor. 2:16; Rom. 8:14, 5-6; Phil. 4:6:

- A. It is possible to know God's thought and leading about any and every matter related to our daily living and future.
- B. Our desire is to have practical fellowship regarding how to seek the Lord's leading, that is, how to know and obey the teaching of the anointing.

V. God's desire and God's joy-1 Tim. 2:3-4; John 15:11; Luke 15:10; Rom. 1:14-16; 1 Cor. 9:16-17:

- A. It is God's desire that all men would be saved and come to the full knowledge of the truth; it is in the context of fruit-bearing that the Lord speaks of *His* joy; and there is joy in the presence of the angels over one sinner repenting.
- B. This shows us that our joy in the Lord can only be made full when we are bearing fruit.
- C. On one hand, as believers, we are debtors to our friends, we owe them the gospel, and we need to discharge this debt of the gospel to our friends before we graduate from high school.
- D. On the other hand, preaching the gospel and shepherding others is a way for us to enter into the real and sustained enjoyment of the Lord.

Outline Two

Knowing the Age and Grasping the Opportunity to Love the Lord in the College Decision-Making Process and Throughout the College Years

Scripture Reading: Rev. 22:20; Matt. 24:14, 37-39; Rev. 19:7-9; Matt. 26:6-13; Luke 10:38-42; John 14:19; Matt. 6:33

- I. We all need to know what age we are in, what the present revelation is from God, where we should be, what we should do, and what flow we should enter into; time is short, and the day of the Lord's second coming is approaching—Rev. 22:12, 20; cf. Matt. 24:37-39; 2 Tim. 3:1-3.
- II. The fulfillment of the Lord's prophecy concerning the building up of His church, the preparation of His bride, will bring Him back; now is the time for the Lord to fulfill His prophecy through the overcomers, who cooperate and coordinate with Christ in His heavenly ministry for His up-to-date and ultimate move—Matt. 16:18; Rev. 19:7-9; Matt. 24:14.
- III. To be the Lord's overcomers, we must love the Lord and grasp the opportunity to love Him-26:6-13:
 - A. To love the Lord with our best requires that we take time to behold Him, listen to His word, and receive a revelation concerning Him; the overcomers have the highest revelation of Christ and offer themselves willingly to the Lord in the splendor of their consecration—Psa. 110:3.
 - B. Mary sat at the Lord's feet and was listening to His word; having heard and received the Lord's word and revelation concerning His death, Mary looked for the opportunity to anoint Him before He died—Luke 10:38-42; Matt. 26:1-2, 12; cf. 16:21; 17:22-23; 20:18-19.
 - C. The Lord prefers His saved ones who love Him to listen to Him (Luke 10:39) that they may know His desire, rather than do things for Him without knowing His will—cf. 1 Sam. 15:22; Eccl. 5:1.
- IV. In order to maintain both our faith and our love for the Lord during the college years, we must watch and be sober—1 Thes. 5:6, 8:
 - A. On the negative side, we should not be ignorant of Satan's schemes in the present age expressed in the philosophy of men (Col. 2:8) of which some examples are:
 - 1. Atheism-cf. Isa. 45:5; Rom. 1:19-20, 28; 2:14-15; Eph. 4:18.
 - 2. Agnosticism—cf. John 14:6; Acts 4:12; 1 John 5:13; Heb. 11:1.
 - 3. Humanism-cf. Gal. 6:10; 1 Tim. 6:17-18; Heb. 13:15-16; Rom. 12:9-21.
 - 4. Moral relativism—cf. Rom. 10:3; 1 John 5:17; Rom. 1:27-28; Lev. 18:22; Lev. 20:13; Gen. 19:5; Judg. 19:22; 1 Cor. 6:9-10; 1 Tim. 1:10; Jude 6-7.
 - 5. Darwinism-cf. Gen. 1:1-2; Isa. 45:18.
 - 6. Materialism—Matt. 6:24; 1 Tim. 6:9-10; 2 Tim. 3:1-4.
 - 7. Individualism—cf. Psa. 139:13-16; Matt. 10:30; Rom. 12:4-5; 1 Cor. 12:14-22.
 - B. On the positive side, we should pay attention to the following:
 - 1. Developing (or cultivating) an intimate, affectionate, personal, and spiritual relationship with the Lord—S. S. 1:2-4a; 2 Cor. 3:16-18.
 - 2. Knowing the Bible-2 Tim. 3:15-16.
 - 3. Knowing God's economy-1 Tim. 1:3-4.
 - 4. Bearing fruit by preaching the gospel—John 15:4-5; Rom. 1:14-16; 1 Cor. 9:16-17; 2 Tim. 4:2.

- 5. Obtaining a proper education, both secular and spiritual—1 Tim. 4:15; 2 Tim. 3:14; cf. 2 Cor. 4:7.
- 6. Living a proper, normal human life in godliness and all gravity—1 Tim. 2:2-4 and notes 22, 23; 4:12.
- 7. Entering into the church life, having companions, and caring for others—Heb. 10:25; 1 Tim. 3:15; 2 Tim. 2:22.



 - 1. Do not abuse your newfound freedom—Gal. 5:13.
 - 2. Beware of the liberal philosophies ("isms") of the age—Col. 2:8; Rom. 12:2.
 - 3. Be very careful in majoring in philosophy or psychology—1 Cor. 2:14.
 - 4. Beware of the snare of fraternities or sororities—Prov. 13:20; 1 Cor. 15:33; 1 Pet. 4:3.
 - 5. Beware of the looseness of life in the dormitories—Gal. 5:17, 19-21; 2 Tim. 2:22.
 - 6. Stay away from alcohol and drugs—1 Cor. 6:19-20; 1 Pet. 4:3.
 - 7. Avoid entering into intimate relationships with people that would encumber you from pursuing the Lord; learn to fellowship—2 Cor. 6:14-15.
 - 8. Flee fornication—1 Cor. 6:18; 1 Thes. 4:4.
 - 9. Do not waste time—Eph. 5:16.
 - 10. Beware of the snare of the Internet and of being engrossed in computer games—1 Cor. 6:12; 10:23.
 - 11. Study without being consumed—1 Cor. 6:12; 10:23.
 - 12. Do not be a loner but also do not be cliquish—Eccl. 4:9-12; 1 Cor. 12:25.






