- 4. This area is important to Christians because it is the historical place of our faith but even more important, we believe the Bible speaks of its place in future events.






The Promise of Land in Genesis 12:5-7

5 Abram took Sarai his wife and Lot his nephew, and all their possessions which they had accumulated, and the persons which they had acquired in Haran, and they set out for the land of Canaan; thus they came to the land of Canaan.

6 Abram passed through the land as far as the site of Shechem, to the oak of Moreh. Now the Canaanite was then in the land.

7 The LORD appeared to Abram and said, "To your descendants I will give this land." So he built an altar there to the LORD who had appeared to him.




Tribal Divisions of the Land




General Borders of Promise Land

Today Israel is about 300 miles in length and an average of 50 miles wide.









Arab Nations of the Middle East and Africa




Surrounded by countries with Muslim majorities












Kingdoms of Saul, David, and Solomon





Deportation of Northern Kingdom
