Three reasons for introducing Abraham here:
1. He illustrates the endurance of hope (cf. 6:12)
2. He is associated with Melchizedek
3. He was assured of the certainty of the promise (6:12)
3. He was assured of the certainty of the profilise (0.12)
The wearing is assessed by two factors
The promise is guaranteed by two factors
a) The oath of God (vv. 1318)
b) The exaltation of the Son (vv. 1920)
