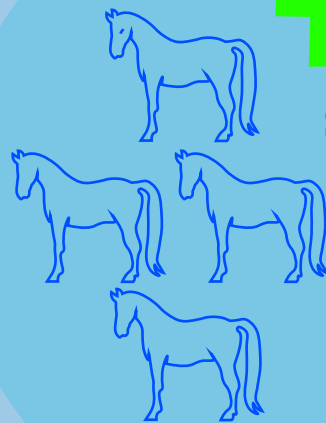
Keep in touch to see whether a visit is really necessary by using the BFBA traffic light system

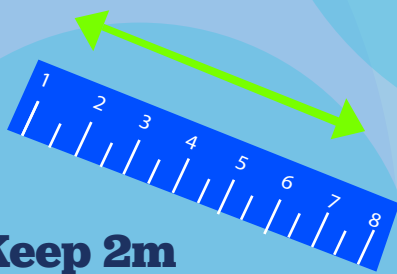

See as many horses as possible in one single visit

Keep 2m between you and any other person

If you work alone, message back to "base" every hour to make sure you are safe

Try not to touch anything apart from your own tools (gate latches, door latches, lead ropes etc should be avoided if you can)

Try not to handle cash, can you take payments electronically?



8

Take your own refreshments, politely say no to tea from clients



9

Wash your hands between visits and wipe down your tools



10

It helps to say "Thank you for keeping your distance"



Remember:

Don't go at all if you, someone at home or on the yard are ill.

Change into different clothes when you finish your day, clean your tools and wash your hands again!
