This letter is an annual report to share all the great things that happened in 2023 along with a financial report and balance sheet for fiscal years 2022 and 2023.

Because of donations from individuals, companies and foundations your state parks made enormous strides last year. Private support helps to restore and repair our parks after increasingly heavy use and the effects of extreme weather.

Here are a few of the amazing things you made happen in 2023:

- 18 park improvement projects were completed, with 22 more in progress across Washington
- 6,890 underserved families accessed parks in the Check Out Washington Adventure Pack Program
- A brand new playground at Ike Kinswa was completed, with another planned at Deception Pass
- Numerous campsites, park entrances, and picnic shelters were repaired and restored
- Refurbishments of amphitheaters, bulletin boards, and kiosks occurred
- Trail, stairway, bridge, and scenic lookout enhancements were made
- New maps and signage were installed for education and easier navigation
- Many new educational opportunities were created through Park Naturalist Internships

It is because donors step up to support state parks that this vital work continues and that state parks continue to be there for the public.

I hope through sharing these few examples of what donations make happen that you know how much your gifts mean to state parks and to all who enjoy them.




