


I-526 Lowcountry Corridor WEST E9 Community Mitigation Survey Results

What was the purpose of the DRAFT EJ Community Mitigation Survey?

To *facilitate full and fair participation* by all potentially impacted Environmental Justice (EJ) communities in the mitigation plan design.

The EJ Community Mitigation Survey period ran from 10/5/2020 to 1/15/2021.

- 199 survey participants
 - 130 paper submissions











Additional Mitigation-Related Comments

The project team received 235 Public Hearing comments; 58% referenced components of the DRAFT EJ Community Mitigation Plan. Concern regarding Rightof-Way or relocation, especially for the elderly and disabled, was the most frequently discussed mitigation-related category.

The second highest categories included noise concerns and requests for infrastructure improvements, such as increased streetlighting, better stormwater drainage, improved pedestrian facilities, or an increase in traffic calming measures.
