Access hours, for now, will be
Mon-Fri 9AM - 8PM, Sat-Sun 12- 8PM.



Reserve blocks of time at Art Gym
in increments of 30 minutes to better
fit your schedule.



Public tours will begin, one person
at a time, with required masks and
following social distancing protocols.



New members will begin to be
accepted. We will be conducting
meet-n-greets and onboards with
safety procedures in place.

by **September 15.**



Art Gym Café will test online
ordering for members and the public
for pick-up only, with strict safety
guidelines in place. Socially distanced
seating will be available to members.

Membership Fees, temporarily,
will continue to be \$50/mo.



Practice social distancing by keeping
6’ between you and others.



Masks are required to be worn by
anyone inside the building.



Continue sanitizing your hands upon
entering the building and sanitizing
your area when finished working.
