

## **CAMPUS MEAL SERVICE**

### **Safely maintaining access to meals**

Modifications will be in place to ensure the safe distribution of meals to students attending in-person instruction and continuing meal service for those students who have qualified for a medical exemption.

#### General Considerations

- Meals will be served in the classroom by teachers. Gloves must be worn and trash will be collected by teachers at the end of meal service.
- Face coverings should only be removed for meals or snacks, placed in a clean and safe area that is clearly marked with the student's name.
- Meals will be individually plated, sharing of utensils or foods is prohibited.
- Students will be allowed to bring meals from home, we are unable to heat lunches from home

### **Meal Distribution – Medical Exemption/Virtual**

Center City has an obligation to continue to provide meals to our students who have qualified for a medical exemption. These students will be offered 5-day meal kits. The following outlines the process for ensuring meals are readily available for pickup.

#### **Campuses must:**

- Designate a 2–3 hour window for students to report to the campus for the purpose of picking up meals
- Place 6ft. markings outside the building in the event a line forms
- Ensure students may enter the building one-at-a-time and stand on the 6th marker at the front desk or set up a designated tent outside the building
- Track the number of meals distributed
- Ensure all meals are reimbursable (breakfast and lunch)

Upon request, students (present and in the building) must be given a packaged meal(s) to take home for every consecutive school day they are virtual in the event exposure takes place.

- MSS should prepare meals and deliver to classrooms prior to dismissal

What constitutes a 5-day Meal Kit?

- Milk
- Complete breakfast entree
- Fruit cup
- Complete lunch entree
- Juice (if applicable)
- Condiments

**Vendor Interaction<sup>17</sup>**

- The vendor will deliver packaged 5-day meal kits and in-person individually packaged meals
- Preferred Meals will resume their partnership with Coastal Fruit for the delivery of whole fruit
- MSS have the option to leave the cafeteria while deliveries are unpacked<sup>18</sup>
- Staff meal service training will be conducted via Zoom
