Jeremiah Robison is the Founder and CEO of Cionic, where he is leading a new frontier in human mobility. A Silicon Valley technologist and entrepreneur with a career spanning Apple, Openwave, Slide, and Jawbone, Jeremiah has dedicated his professional life to creating products that shape how people live, connect, and perform.

That journey took a deeply personal turn when his daughter was diagnosed with cerebral palsy. Confronted with the reality that mobility solutions had barely advanced beyond crutches and wheelchairs, Jeremiah set out to build something radically better. In 2018, he founded Cionic with a bold vision: to harness the power of software, hardware, and machine learning to restore movement across the entire human body, starting with walking.

Today, under his leadership, Cionic is pioneering wearable neurotechnology that adapts in real time to the body's needs, bringing independence and new possibilities to millions of people living with mobility challenges.

Jeremiah earned his master's degree in computer science from Stanford University.
