

Spa and Gym Rules

All landlords and tenants are supposed to be aware of these rules and comply with them.

Cleanliness and ingenuity in the Spa are our main concern.

We count on your cooperation

- Open from 08:00 to 21:00. The Spa will be closed from 15 June to 15 September.
- Reservations must be made on the board at the entrance.
- The Gym does not need to be booked (max. 4 persons).
- The use of the Spa is limited to 1 hour per household/day and a maximum of 6 persons.
- Bathrobe, towel and slippers are required to enter the Spa.
- Bathing cap to get into the jacuzzi
- For the Gym towel and trainers
- It is compulsory to shower before using the Jacuzzi and sauna, soaps and gels may not be used.
- The use of towels on sun loungers, sauna and benches is compulsory.
- Switch on the sauna before use and switch it off when leaving.
- Do not enter the sauna with wet feet and use the towel to sit on.
- Do not use sun creams when entering the jacuzzi and sauna.
- Do not disturb other users
- It is forbidden to enter the Jacuzzi wearing T-shirts.
- No smoking
- Music equipment prohibited, only if headphones are used.
- No pets allowed
- No topless allowed
- No alcoholic beverages and food
- No crystal glasses
- No mats, floats or boats in the Jacuzzi.
- Respect the opening hours of the Spa and leave it on time.
- The spa should be left tidy, clean and free of water on the floor, using the water catcher to carry the water to the drain.
If this is not the case, extra costs may be charged for cleaning. The camera will record entry and exit
- The gym should be left tidy, and the machines used should be disinfected with the liquid we have left for this purpose.
- It is forbidden to take weights and other items out of the Gym.
- In the Spa and Gym, children under 16 years of age must always be accompanied by an adult.
- Inappropriate behaviour may lead to expulsion.
- There is no place for eroticism in the spa, and in the event of an offence, the local police will be called in.
- The user is responsible for his or her own health. In case of doubt about the use of the Spa and Gym, the advice of a medical specialist should be sought first.

- The user is responsible for the correct use of the facilities. The Area Beach II Committee is not responsible for accidents, physical or material damage and will never be obliged to pay compensation for this. If damage caused by irresponsible behaviour and the Spa or other common elements cannot function properly, a compensation of 150€/per day should be paid from the day the damage was caused until the day it is repaired.
- Damage caused by the owner, tenant or user must be reported immediately to the Beach II Area Committee.
and shall be liable for compensation for such damage.
- The Area Beach II Committee has the right to refuse access to or remove from the Spa/Gym/Pool any person who appears to be a danger to themselves or others and any person who does not comply with the general rules and terms.
In the case of serious infringements, the local police will be called in.
- Holiday licence holders must inform their tenants of these regulations and enforce them and can be held liable for any damages.
- Spanish law shall apply in case of conflict of laws
