

ORDINANCE NO. 3442-18

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUTHERFORD,
COUNTY OF BERGEN, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 126, ARTICLE I,
SECTION 69 ENTITLED "DESIGNATION OF SPACES"**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Rutherford, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey (not less than a majority of those Council Members present affirmatively concurring), and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-1, 40:49-2, and 39:4-197.5, that the portions of Chapter 126, Section 69 of the Code of the Borough of Rutherford set forth below entitled "Designation of Spaces" are hereby repealed as follows and that those portions of the Ordinance not set forth below shall remain unchanged:

The following portion of Rutherford Code §126-69A is hereby repealed:

The portions of Section A. pertaining to a handicap space located on Chestnut Street which states:

Name of Street:	Side:	Location:
Chestnut Street	East	Commencing 73 feet from the intersection of West Passaic Avenue and Chestnut Street running northeasterly for a distance of 22 feet.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Rutherford, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that Chapter 126, Section 69A of the Code of the Borough of Rutherford Entitled "Designation of spaces" shall be amended and that those portions of the Ordinance set forth below are hereby

amended as follows and that those portions of the Ordinance not set forth below shall remain unchanged:

§ 126-69A Designation of Spaces

A. Public street spaces (minimum length 22 feet each).

Name of Street:	Side:	Location:
Park Ave	West	Commencing 113 feet from the northwest intersection of West Passaic Avenue and running southerly for a distance of 22 feet.
Wood Street	West	Commencing 155 feet from the southeast intersection of Washington Avenue and Wood Street and running southerly for a distance of 22 feet.
