

ORDINANCE NO. 3488-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE II, SCHEDULE OF FEES, SECTIONS 4 AND 5, RESPECTIVELY ENTITLED “FEES ESTABLISHED” AND “EFFECTIVE DATE” OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RUTHERFORD, COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Rutherford, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey (not less than a majority of those Council Members present affirmatively concurring), and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-1 and 40:49-2, that the portions of Chapter 16, Article II, Schedule of Fees, Sections 4 and 5 of the Code of the Borough of Rutherford set forth below respectively entitled “Fees established” and “Effective date” are hereby repealed as follows and that those portions of the Ordinance not set forth below shall remain unchanged:

The following portion of Rutherford Code §16-4 and §16-5 are hereby repealed:

Article II Schedule of Fees

§ 16-4 Fees established. [1]

The following fees are hereby established for the services of the Physician, Veterinarian, Plumbing Inspector and Board of Plumbing Examiners.

A. The Physician and Plumbing Inspector shall be paid on a basis that will be established yearly by the Board of Health pursuant to such ordinances heretofore adopted or which may hereafter be adopted providing for a fee to the Board of Health for such services; provided, however, that the fees herein established for the Physician shall be in addition and separate from any salary or other remuneration paid to him for services for which there is no provision by law or ordinance for the payment of fees therefor to the Board of Health.

B. The Veterinarian shall be paid a fee of \$4 for each animal examined, except if the same animal is examined a second time, the second examination fee will be \$3.[2]

- C. The Board of Plumbing Examiners shall be paid a fee equal in amount to the fee received by the Board of Health for the service rendered by that Board pursuant to the ordinance establishing the Plumbing Code, which said fee shall be divided among the members of said Board of Plumbing Examiners in such proportion as they shall determine.[3]

§ 16-5 Effective date.

This article shall take effect 30 days after the first publication thereof in accordance with N.J.S.A. 26-3:69.

Section 2. Any Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and shall be amended and supplemented to conform to the provisions contained herein.

Section 3. If any part of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or illegal by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after the first publication thereof in accordance with N.J.S.A. 26:3-69.
