

ORDINANCE NO. 3502-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 61, SECTIONS 9, 12, 16 AND 19 OF THE CODE OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RUTHERFORD RESPECTIVELY ENTITLED "RESERVED AND VISITORS PARKING", "PORTION RESERVED FOR POLICE AND AMBULANCE CORPS, AMBULANCE SQUAD AND FIRE DEPARTMENT", "ERECTION OF SIGNS", AND "WHEN EFFECTIVE" COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Rutherford, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that Chapter 61, Sections 9, 12, 16 and 19 of the Code of the Borough of Rutherford respectively entitled "Reserved and visitors parking", "Portion reserved for Police and Ambulance Corps, Ambulance Squad and Fire Department", "Erection of signs", and "When effective" shall be amended and that those portions of the Ordinances set forth below are hereby amended as follows and that those portions of the Ordinances not set forth below shall remain unchanged:

§ 61-9 Reserved and visitors parking

A. There shall be ~~two~~ **three** parking spaces located next to the ~~handicapped~~ **accessible** parking spaces on the easterly side of the Municipal Building parking lot reserved for visitors to the Municipal Building or the Municipal Annex. No vehicle shall be permitted to park in said reserved spaces for a period exceeding 30 minutes between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

D. Fifteen-minute courtesy parking of nonelectric vehicles in designated "charging station" spaces within the Borough Hall parking lot shall be permitted for those having business in the Municipal Building or the Municipal Annex on Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. only. ~~Fifteen-minute courtesy parking of nonelectric vehicles in designated "charging station" spaces at the Memorial Field parking lot for pickup and drop-off only shall be permitted.~~ **All other times parking for electric vehicles only while charging.**

§ 61-12 Portion reserved for Police and Ambulance Corps, Ambulance Squad and Fire Department

B. The parking of vehicles in the **Ames Avenue Firehouse and the** Ambulance Corps parking lot shall be limited to Ambulance Corps, Ambulance Squad and Fire Department vehicles and motor vehicles owned and/or being used by members in good standing of the Ambulance Corps, Ambulance Squad and Fire Department. The parking of motor vehicles by the general

public is hereby prohibited. Areas not specifically marked as parking spaces shall be deemed as a driveway.

C. The parking of vehicles in the Mortimer Avenue Firehouse and the Union Avenue Firehouse parking lot shall be limited to Fire Department vehicles and motor vehicles owned and/or being used by members in good standing of the Fire Department. The parking of motor vehicles by the general public is hereby prohibited. Areas not specifically marked as parking spaces shall be deemed as a driveway.

§ 61-16 ~~Erection of signs~~ Fifteen-minute courtesy parking of nonelectric vehicles

~~The effectiveness of this article is contingent on signs being erected as required by law.~~
Fifteen-minute courtesy parking of nonelectric vehicles in designated "charging station" spaces at the Memorial Field parking lot for pickup and drop off only shall be permitted. All other times parking for electric vehicles only while charging.

§ 61- 17 ~~Removal of vehicles; payment of costs~~ Erection of signs

The effectiveness of this article is contingent on signs being erected as required by law.

§ 61-18 ~~Removal of vehicles; payment of costs~~ Violations and penalties

Any unoccupied vehicle parked in violation of this article shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic, and any peace officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner shall pay the reasonable cost of the removal and storage which may result from the removal before regaining possession of the vehicle.

§ 61- 19 Violations and penalties ~~When effective~~

Any person or persons, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined a sum of \$30 for each offense and, in default of payment thereof, be imprisoned in the county jail for a term not exceeding five days, or both.

§ 61- 20 When effective

This article shall take effect immediately upon publication according to law.
