

ORDINANCE NO. 3514-19

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 82A, SECTION 5,
ENTITLED "GENERAL REQUIREMENTS" OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES
OF THE BOROUGH OF RUTHERFORD, COUNTY OF BERGEN
AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Rutherford, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that Chapter 82A (Recycling), Sections 5, Entitled "General requirements" of the Code of the Borough of Rutherford shall be amended and that those portions of the Ordinances set forth below are hereby amended as follows and that those portions of the Ordinances not set forth below shall remain unchanged:

§ 82A General requirements

A. All persons, except those physically disabled, who are owners, lessees or occupants of property in the Borough shall separate newspapers, magazines, aluminum, glass and metal from any other solid waste produced by any such residences and shall ~~separately bundle the same~~ **place them in the blue Borough issued automated cans** for pickup, collection and recycling in accordance with applicable regulations.

B. ~~From September 1 to December 31 of each year,~~ The owner, lessee or occupant of every property within the Borough shall source separate leaves **and vegetative waste** from solid waste generated at that property. ~~Leaves shall be placed in the street at curbside in front of the property either in loose piles~~ **and vegetative waste that are placed curbside for collection shall be in either garbage cans or biodegradable paper bags.** ~~Leaves may not be placed in plastic bags except on those specific roadways designated by regulation.~~ **Leaves must not be placed in the street. Leaves may not be placed in plastic bags or in the Borough issued automated cans.**

C. ~~From April 1 to November 1 of each year,~~ The owner, lessee or occupant of every property within the Borough shall source separate grass clippings from solid waste generated at that property. Grass clippings shall be placed at curbside for collection on scheduled days. ~~Grass clippings placed at curbside for collection shall be in either garbage cans or biodegradable paper bags.~~

E. Sweeping, raking, blowing or otherwise placing yard waste that is not containerized at the curb or along the street is prohibited ~~except during the seven days before a scheduled and announced municipal collection.~~
