

ORDINANCE NO. 3519-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 73, SECTIONS 6, 7, AND 8, RESPECTIVELY ENTITLED “APPLICATION PROCEDURES”, “IMPOSITION OF FEES”, AND “SCHEDULE OF FEES” OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RUTHERFORD, COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Rutherford, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that Chapter 73, Sections 6, 7, and 8, Respectively Entitled “Application procedures”, “Imposition of fees: and “Schedule of fees” of the Code of the Borough of Rutherford shall be amended and that those portions of the Ordinance set forth below are hereby amended as follows and that those portions of the Ordinances not set forth below shall remain unchanged:

§ 73-6 Application procedures.

Except as expressly waived or amended via resolution of the governing body or by other provisions set forth within the Borough Code pertaining to resident companies that have a physical location that is geographically located in the Borough of Rutherford, or when circumstances exist requiring a one time action to amend a fee for any event;

A. The following shall be followed:

§ 73-7 Imposition of fees.

F. If there is no meeting of the governing body scheduled before the event in time to pass a resolution regarding application procedures set forth at Section 73-6, or amending any fees set forth within Section 73-8, then the Borough Administrator is authorized to use his/her discretion regarding same.

§ 73-8 Schedule of fees.

Except as expressly waived or amended via resolution of the governing body or by other provisions set forth within the Borough Code pertaining to resident companies that have a physical location that is geographically located in the Borough of

Rutherford, or when circumstances exist requiring a one time action to amend a fee for any event;

A. Picnic, bandshell or park permits.
