

ORDINANCE NO. 3602-22

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND REVISE CHAPTER 126 “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUTHERFORD

WHEREAS the Governing Body of the Borough of Rutherford believes it is in the best interest of the Borough to amend and revise §126 entitled “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” of the Borough Code to amend parking meter charges.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Rutherford, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 126 of the Borough Code be amended as follows:

SECTION 1.

§ 126-37 Parking meter charges.

Vehicles shall not park, stop or stand for a period exceeding the time limits established by this section between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., prevailing time, except Sundays and holidays, in a parking space regulated by a parking meter; nor shall coins be deposited in parking meters beyond the period of legal parking time established and nor shall any vehicle be moved from parking space to parking space in an attempt to circumvent the time limits established, in the areas where parking is permitted on the below listed streets, avenues and roads, and the charge for parking a motor vehicle on said public streets, avenues and roads shall be at the following rates:

A.

Park Avenue (Station Square to Pierrepont Avenue); Station Square; Ames Avenue; Franklin Place (Park Avenue to Chestnut Street); Orient Way (Station Square to Glen Road); Glen Road; Ridge Road (Park Avenue to East Passaic Avenue); Sylvan Street (Spring Dell to The Terrace); The Terrace (Park Avenue to Sylvan Street); Highland Cross (Park Avenue to Lincoln Avenue); West End District (Union Avenue and Santiago Avenue); West Erie Avenue, south side (Union Avenue to Agnew Place); Union Avenue (West Erie Avenue to Ayer Place); and Agnew Place (Union Avenue to West Erie Avenue).

(1)

Fees on all meters shall be as follows: ~~\$0.10 for 10 minutes of parking time,~~ **\$0.25 for 30 each 15 minutes of parking time,** and ~~\$0.50 for 60 minutes.~~

(2)

The parking of any vehicle in excess of two hours is hereby prohibited.

B.

Orient Way (Glen Road to East Passaic Avenue); Spring Dell (Sylvan Street to Orient Way); Ettrick Terrace (Spring Dell to Orient Way).

(1)

Fees on all meters shall be as follows: ~~\$0.10 for 10 minutes of parking time~~, \$0.25 for 30 ~~each~~ **15 minutes of parking time.**

(2)

The parking of any vehicle in excess of three hours is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 2.

§ 126-38 Computation of public parking lot fees.

Fees for use of public parking lots shall be computed as follows:

A.

~~Etrick Terrace lot. Fees on all meters shall be as follows:~~

~~Fees on all meters shall be as follows: \$0.10 for 10 minutes of parking time, \$0.25 for 30 minutes, and \$0.50 for 60 minutes.~~

~~The parking of any vehicle in excess of three hours is hereby prohibited, except as provided in Article V.~~

B. A.

Kip Avenue lot.

(1)

Fees on all meters shall be as follows: ~~\$0.10 for 10 minutes of parking time~~, \$0.25 for 30 ~~each~~ **15 minutes of parking time**, and ~~\$0.50 for 60 minutes.~~

(2)

The parking of any vehicle in excess of three hours is hereby prohibited. ~~except as provided in Subsection B(3) below.~~

(3)

~~Ten parking meters located on the top of the Kip Avenue Parking Garage facility shall be designated so as to permit the parking of motor vehicles for a period of time not exceeding four hours. The parking of any vehicle in these designated spaces in excess of four hours is hereby prohibited.~~

C. B.

Erie Avenue Park N' Ride lot. Fees on all meters shall be as follows:

Fifty cents **\$1.00** for each hour of parking time for a period of time not exceeding 12 hours.

(2)

The parking of any vehicle in excess of 12 hours is hereby prohibited.

Section 3.

§ 126-9.2 ~~Truck p~~ Parking restricted: business districts.

A. ~~The parking of any trucks or vehicle~~ **The parking of any passenger vehicle or** using commercial license plates or having advertising affixed to exterior surfaces, while **unloading or loading or** providing services to local commercial/business establishments **or residents**, on any streets within the limits of a business zone district by any person other than agents or employees of the borough is hereby prohibited, unless:

(1) When any such vehicle shall be parked in any space adjacent to a parking meter, the operator of said vehicle shall, upon entering the said parking space, immediately deposit or cause to be deposited in such parking meter the coin or coins of the United States of America required for such parking, in accordance with the directions for the same attached to said meter; or

(2) An application for a permit pursuant to this chapter shall be made on forms approved and made available by the Borough Clerk, which application shall include but not be limited to the following information:

(a) The name and address of the applicant and the name and address of the registered owner of the motor vehicle.

(b) The make, model number, year, vehicle identification number and license plate number of the motor vehicle.

(c) The length of time the applicant plans to park said motor vehicle at the parking meter, such time not to exceed three consecutive days between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. **All other borough ordinances and state statues shall remain if full effect.**¹¹¹

Section 4.

§ 126-9.3 Permit fee.

[Added 10-3-1995 by Ord. No. 2741-95; amended 3-21-2000 by Ord. No. 2930-00]

A. Commercial vehicle, contractor, commercial/business establishment fee:

- (1) A fee of ~~\$5~~ **\$25** per day for each parking space shall be paid to the Borough Clerk before any permit or renewed permit is issued pursuant to § 126-9.2A(2).

B. Passenger vehicle, resident fee:

- (1) A fee of **\$25** per day for each parking space shall be paid to the Borough Clerk before any permit or renewed permit is issued pursuant to § 126-9.2A(2)

Section 5.

§ 126-10 Parking during emergencies.

- A. Upon the declaration of an emergency, there shall be no parking upon the streets or sections of streets where temporary emergency no-parking signs are displayed. The Chief of Police or, in his absence, the ranking police officer is authorized to declare an emergency and to direct the posting of said emergency no-parking signs when weather conditions, accidents, fires, public celebrations or other facts or events are found to dictate or require the avoidance of hazards or other conditions which interfere with the free flow of traffic. Notification that the emergency no-parking signs are being or will be posted shall be given to the operator or owner of any vehicle which has been parked prior to the posting of the signs.

B. "No Parking" sign Fee


- (1) A fee of **\$1** for each "No Parking" sign for each parking space shall be paid to the Borough Clerk before any permit or renewed permit is issued.
- (2) Any other request for "No Parking" signs shall pay a fee of **\$1** for each sign requested paid to the Borough Clerk.

SECTION 6. All ordinances of the Borough of Rutherford, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.




SECTION 8 All other provisions of §126 of the Code of the Borough of Rutherford are not further amended and remain in full force and effect.
