

ORDINANCE NO. 3609-22

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND REVISE CHAPTER 126 “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUTHERFORD

WHEREAS the Governing Body of the Borough of Rutherford believes it is in the best interest of the Borough to Amend and Revise Chapter 126 entitled “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” of the Borough Code.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Rutherford, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. § 126-29. of the Borough Code of the Borough of Rutherford, entitled “Parking within lines or markings” is hereby amended to add the following revisions:

§ 126-29 Parking within lines or markings.

A. The Police Department shall have lines or markings placed adjacent to each parking meter for the purpose of designating the parking space for which said meter is to be used, and each vehicle parked adjacent to or next to any parking meter shall park within the lines or markings so established. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle across any such lines or markings. **It shall be unlawful to park in any metered zone except between any two parking meter street lines or markings.**

B. ~~It shall be unlawful to park in any metered zone except between any two parking meter street lines or markings.~~ **The Police Department shall have lines or markings placed adjacent to each angle parking space for the purpose of designating the angle parking space and each vehicle parked adjacent to or next to any angle parking space shall park within the lines or markings so established. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle across any such lines or markings.**

C. The Police Department shall have lines or markings placed adjacent to each permit parking space for the purpose of designating the permit parking space for which said permit is to be used, and each vehicle parked adjacent to or next to any permit parking space shall park within the lines or markings so established. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle across any such lines or markings.

D. **The Police Department shall have lines or markings placed adjacent to each reserved parking space, time limited parking space, or any other marked parking space for the purpose of designating the parking space for such use and each vehicle parked adjacent to or next to such parking space shall park within the lines or markings so established. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle across any such lines or markings.**

SECTION 2. § 126-58. of the Borough Code of the Borough of Rutherford, entitled “Angle parking established” is hereby amended to add the following revisions:

§ 126-58 Angle parking established.

A. The establishment of zones, to be known as "angle parking zones," permitting the ~~ninety-degree~~ angle parking of motor vehicles ~~within delineated parking stall lines~~ in the following streets is hereby authorized, **except in those areas where parking would otherwise be prohibited by state statute.**

- (1) The easterly side of Veteran's Boulevard commencing 62 feet from the intersection of Veteran's Boulevard and Altman Drive and continuing southerly for a distance of 563 feet. ~~except in those areas where parking would otherwise be prohibited by state statute.~~
- (2) Hastings Avenue commencing at a point on both sides of Hastings Avenue at 210 feet from the intersection with Darwin Avenue and running westerly to its terminus.
- (3) **The southerly side of The Terrace between Park Avenue and Sylvan Street.**

SECTION 3. All ordinances of the Borough of Rutherford, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. All other provisions of Chapter 126 of the Code of the Borough of Rutherford are not further amended and remain in full force and effect.


The ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage.
