Citizens and organizations across the nation are asked to toll bells 21 times with five-second intervals between tolls beginning at 11:00 am on Sunday, November 11, 2018.

The time is significant in that it marks the exact moment one hundred years ago that the Armistice went into effect ending World War I,
“The War to End All Wars.”

Symbolic of the country’s highest honor, bells will be tolled to remember those who served, fought and may have perished during wartime.
