Hello. According to the Rutherford Health Department, as of 3:00 pm today, the total number of COVID-19 positive cases reported in Rutherford since March 18th is 196. We have had three days in a row of zero positive cases.

The new resident who has recently reported positive is 66 years old. The situation continues to be closely monitored by our Health Department. Our first responders continue to take all possible precautions when assisting our community.
