Homeowners and Tenants, which provides a direct cash benefit to eligible homeowners and renters.

Filing deadline is February 28, 2023.

Who is eligible for the ANCHOR program?

ANCHOR eligibility is as follows:

- Homeowners with income of \$150,000 or less will receive \$1,500.
- Homeowners with income of more than \$150,000 and up to \$250,000 will receive \$1,000.
- Renters with income of \$150,000 or less will receive \$450.

Per Rutherford ordinance, no sump pumps are to discharge into the sewer?
