


Second Quarter Property Taxes Due May 1

From the Borough Administrator

This week we held the ribbon cutting ceremony for the new Police Headquarters and Municipal Court Building. This was the largest municipal project in decades for the Borough. While it faced many difficulties and challenges throughout construction, I think we can all agree the final product was well worth the wait. I want to commend the men and women of the Rutherford Police Department for their patience throughout the process and also for never complaining about the less than ideal conditions they worked through during my five years here with the Borough. This is just another example of the high quality and professionalism of our Police Department.

I also want to thank the Borough Hall employees for all of their cooperation and understanding during construction. They certainly were negatively impacted and inconvenienced for the last 2 and half years but continued to serve the residents well.

The new parking lot is now available for employees and visitors. In a few weeks, it will be closed for a several days to correct a drainage issue but otherwise it is open. Spaces behind the old police building are also available for all. The West Passaic Avenue lot is NOT available to the public and is limited to police personnel only.

In the coming weeks, the Police Department and the Violations Bureau will continue to transition over to the new building. The last piece will be the relocation of the Police Dispatch center. This requires State review and approval but we expect that to occur hopefully late next month. The public should continue reporting any issues to the old headquarters until further notice.

I'm sure many of you are wondering about Mayor/Council meetings. The plan is to begin holding our meetings in the new Chambers/Court Room later this spring. We want to allow the police to get settled in and for all of us to get familiar with the new technology in the room. We are looking forward to it and hopefully you are as well.

On another note, this week I made a presentation to the Governing Body and the public at the Mayor/Council meeting on the CY2023 Borough budget. A copy of the presentation is available on our website for review. The public will have an opportunity to comment on the budget at our next meeting on May 2nd.
