Parking Meters

By now you may have noticed that our DPW employees are busy removing the old parking meters and the meter vendor will install the new and improved digital ones next week. These new meters are solar and battery powered and will be able to accept quarters, debit/credit cards and payment via a phone app.

Please Note: RPD <u>will NOT enforce parking payments</u> throughout the Borough during the removal and installation period. Enforcement will resume Tuesday, August 30th.

I'd like to thank DPW for quickly removing all 466 old meters to and having them ready for installation as well as all the Borough employees who spent so much time researching and implementing the right product for Rutherford.

Pickleball

Just in time for the nice fall weather, we hope to have Pickleball Courts open at Tamblyn Field as well as resurfaced basketball courts. As we finish the Phase 1 reimaging of Tamblyn, we will also improve the walking path from Woodland Avenue to the courts.


