2024 Municipal Property Tax Calculation 101*

- (Taxes Raised / Borough Assessment) x 100 = Tax Rate
 (\$26,563,856 /2,743,075,361) x 100 = \$0.968
- 2024 Municipal Tax on Avg. Assed Home: (\$437,200 *0.968) / 100 = \$4,232.10 (\$352.68 per month)
 Approximately 31.0% of your total property tax bill

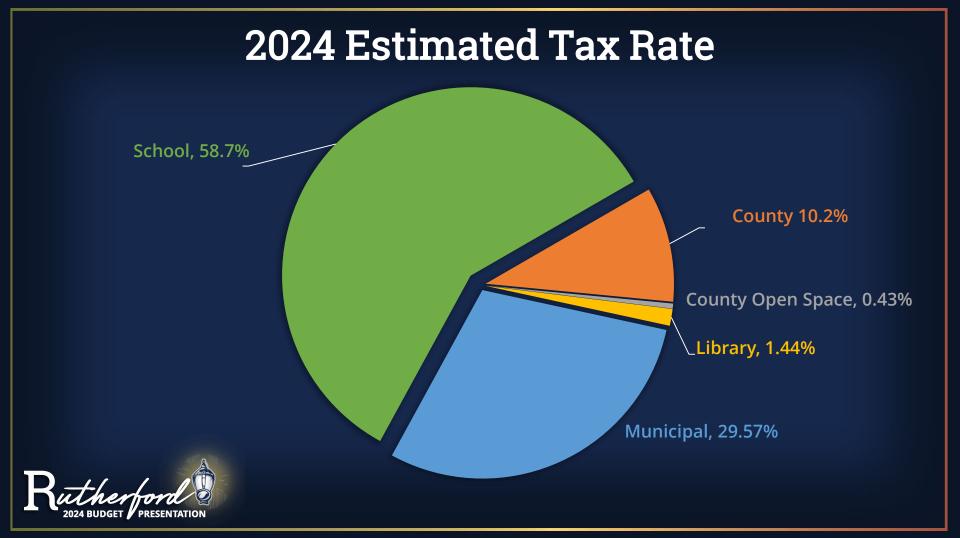

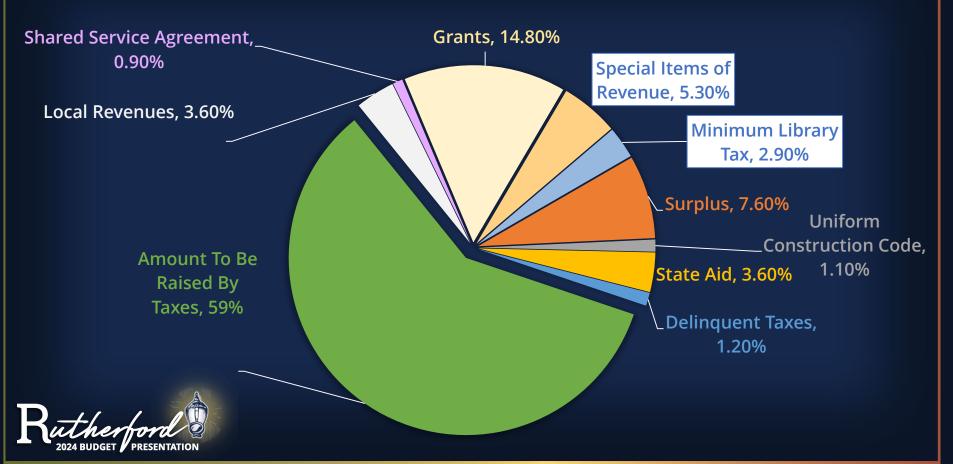

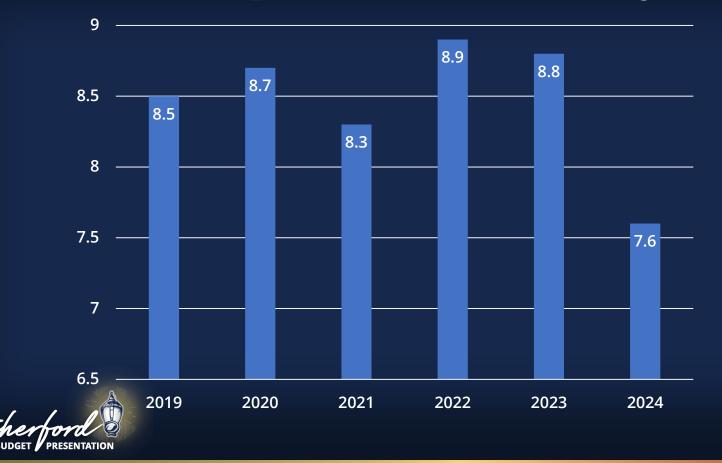

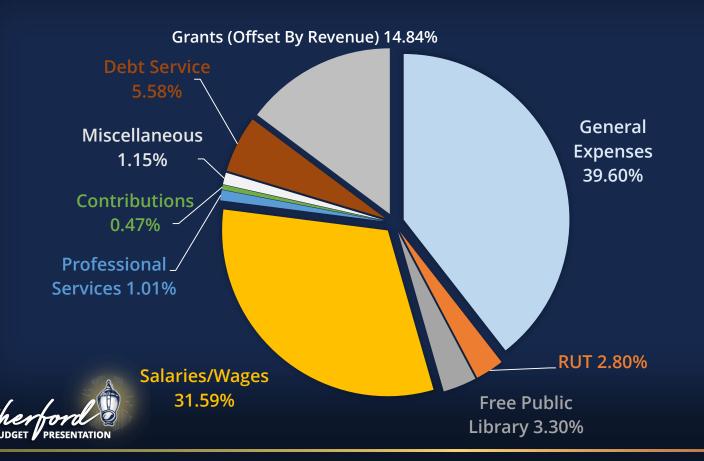

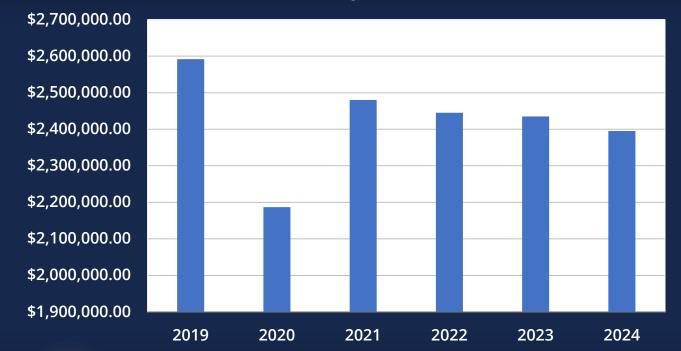
