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A Word From The Team

The pandemic made 2020 an especially challenging year for patients forced to relocate for critical treatment.

As the first wave of COVID-19 swept across Canada, the few facilities that exist like Ronald McDonald House reduced the number of nights served or closed. Typically, these facilities are well beyond capacity when operating at 100%, often with long waiting lists. These closures put even more pressure on patients to find alternative solutions for accommodation.

Additionally, StayWell opened its doors to help frontline healthcare and long-term care (LTC) staff isolate from their families to support Canada's COVID-19 efforts.


In 2020, StayWell stepped up in a big way providing over 11,000 room nights.

Looking to the future, and with the national rollout of vaccines by mid-2021, we expect medical procedures to increase beyond normal capacity to make up for lost time. There is a substantial backlog of surgeries and treatments; inevitably, there will be a dramatic increase in the number of patients requiring affordable accommodation while undergoing critical treatment to access the healthcare they need.

The time to act is now and we urgently need your help!

Our Story

Healing Has A Home

In 2015 Ottawa resident Tina Proulx learned that she needed a life-saving double-lung transplant at Toronto General Hospital. Tina and her husband Joel were forced to stop working and move to Toronto.

Desperate to find affordable housing, Tina said "a lot of people politely told us that we simply don't qualify because we don't have jobs." Tina reached out to Sky View Suites (a corporate housing provider in Toronto) for support. Sky View Suites stepped up to provide affordable accommodations for Tina and her family.

This serendipitous encounter with Tina led to the creation, in 2018, of StayWell Suites Charity. Our mission is to provide affordable housing for patients who must relocate to major cities for critical treatment.



About Us

Since 2018, StayWell Suites Charity has helped hundreds of children and adults find affordable accommodations while undergoing critical treatment. From our modest beginning of 135 room nights serving 3 patients in 2018, we've provided over 11,000 room nights serving 291 patients and healthcare workers in 2020.

There are three pillars to our service:

Accommodations

We match patients with affordable accommodations in safe communities close to major hospitals.

Funding

Donations are absolutely vital to StayWell. We also provide patients with access to fundraising tools, including information on federal and provincial funding, as well as access to our myStayWell platform (crowdfunding tool).

Community

We provide patients with a peer support program to help them navigate the challenges of relocating.

To provide accessible/reduced-cost accommodations to patients required to relocate for medical treatment.




To provide affordable accommodations to all Canadians needing to relocate for medical treatment.


Our Suites


StayWell provided more than 11,000 room nights to those in need in 2020 for patients and their families migrating from across Canada to receive medical treatment and support frontline healthcare workers.

All of our suites are close to core hospitals in urban centers.

Suite sizes range from 1 to 3 bedrooms to accommodate patients, caregivers and their families.

The StayWell Healing & Support Network Aims To Provide:


Sense of Community




