Amenities at The INN

- Access to nearby resources within walking distance.
- The design emphasizes curb appeal and privacy.
- Open 24/7 year-round.
- Provides safe and secure housing until permanent housing can be found.
- Accommodations for up to 30 guests.
- Services offered only to residents of Southeast Manitoba.



Steps to Reducing Homelessness and Crime

Housing-Focused Recovery

Each guest will be offered help to meet their unique physical, emotional, spiritual, and mental health needs. A trauma-sensitive focus means that guests enjoy a safe space while working on recovery and permanent housing solutions. Guests will enjoy a relaxed social environment, while becoming equipped with necessary life-skills to transition back into the community.

Staff Training and Community Engagement

Staff trained in Addictions and Community Outreach will focus on the day to day needs of guests and homelessness prevention. To do this, collaboration with community and other service providers is essential. Space will be available on site for providers of health care, addiction recovery, mental health support, spiritual care, and, employment services.

Reducing Crime and Violence

Persons experiencing homelessness are more likely to be victims rather than perpetrators of violence but may engage in theft or vandalism out of desperation. The INN aims to reduce neighbourhood crime by meeting guests' basic needs and offering essential services.

Collaborative Safety Measures

The INN will build trusting relationships with people experiencing homelessness, encourage them to seek help, and collaborate with the RCMP and security teams to help promote safety in the area.
