Key cabinet KBC-137 / KBC-80 / KBC-40

How to mount the product on the wall

- 1. Determine the location the cabinet is to be mounted.
- 2. Drill the first top mounting hole and tap the wall anchor into the hole. Drive a screw into the wall anchor. Leave a small gap between the screw head and anchor.
- 3. Hang the cabinet on the first screw and mark the remaining holes. Use a level line tool to make sure the cabinet is level. Remove the cabinet.
- 4. Drill the remaining mounting holes.
- 5. Tap the wall anchors into the remaining holes.
- 6. Drive a screw into the remaining top wall anchor, leaving a small gap between the screw head and the anchor.
- 7. Position the key-holes of the cabinet over the screws and pull down to lock it in place.
- 8. Drive the remaining screws into the bottom wall anchors and tighten all mounting screws.


Attention:

- Use a stud finder to locate the studs in the wall.


 It is recommended to attach two of the fasteners to a wall stud or other solid support.
- Before drilling, ensure that no interference will occur with any plumbing, electrical, fire, or security.
- Please ensure that all the screws are used and fixed properly.
- The wall must be strong enough for a screw of 2cm or longer to attach the product securely.
- Please use screws included or screws with a screw head of 7mm in diameter.

Caution:

- Please read the instruction manual carefully and use the product properly.
- Please keep the product in a safe place out of reach of children and infants to prevent them from swallowing the small components such as a key tag.
- After keys are stored, the weight of the product increases significantly. If the product is to be mounted on the wall, please ensure that it is mounted properly to prevent it from falling.
- Do not alter, disassemble or repair the product.
- Do not use the product for the purpose other than what is originally intended.
- If the product is in an upright position, please ensure not to topple it over. After using it, please close the cover and lay it flat.
- Please note that any stored items caught between the body and the cover can cause damage.
- Please do not attempt to close the key cabinet with the lock cylinder is in the lock position. Doing so may cause damage to they key cabinet.
- Please be careful not to get your hands or fingers caught when closing the cover.
- Please be careful not to lose the key for the lock.









1 Lock Unit



How to remove reference sheet -


When removing the key reference sheet, carefully lift, slightly bend and pull out the "L" shape hinge at the bottom as illustrated.

How to change pass code?


Default pass code is 0000. Scroll the dial to set correct pass code, and then turn the knob to open position.



Change the selector on the back of the lock unit to position "B".



Scroll each number dial to your desired 4 digits numbers.




Change the selector on the back of the unit back to position "A".

How to find the pass code when you lost it?

x 2 pcs

1 Insert the key into key hole and turn it to open position.



2 While pressing the key board buttons on the back of the unit, scroll through the dial until it will not allow you to scroll.
