

### Primary PE and Sports Premium Review 2017 – 2018

A government grant of £1000 was awarded to The Iffley Academy to fund additional and sustained improvements to the provision of PE and sport and primary age students to help them develop healthy and active lifestyles.

Develop social and communication skills and a greater awareness of healthy living	Terms 5 & 6	N/A	SB	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 2 x students developed their social skills by stepping up to become peer mentors throughout the session</li> <li>- 1 x student demonstrated positive engagement with all sessions, undertaking the role of coach; asking subject specific questioning and supporting peers</li> </ul>
