- b. The Tuition and Fee Schedule is approved annually by the Board of Trustees:

- i. **Application Fee:** One-time fee payable upon submission of an application. Non-refundable (the « **Application Fee** »)
 - ii. **Capital Assessment Fee:** A one-time joining fee for each new student (the “**Capital Assessment Fee**”), non-refundable
 - iii. **Tuition Fee:** Annual fee dependent on the child’s age, grade or class. Covers mandatory learning resources and day or residential school visits (the « **Tuition Fee** »)
 - iv. **Re-enrollment Fee:** Payable, at the same time as the signature of the Re-enrollment Form to secure a child’s place at school for the following year (the “**Re-enrollment Fee**”)

Together, these fees are referred to as the “**Overall Fees**”.

- c. School services such as the school bus, daily hot lunch and weekly enrichment activities, are extra, not included in the Tuition Fees and are invoiced and paid separately;
- d. Extra fees may be charged for participation in optional excursions or competitions throughout the year;
- e. The Tuition and Fee Schedule is adjusted on an annual basis at the discretion of the Board of Trustees.

Together, these fees are referred to as the “**Additional Fees**”.

7. Payment terms

- a. The **Application Fee** is payable **upon submission** of an application and is non-refundable;
- b. The **Capital Assessment Fee** must be paid **within 14 days** of an offer of admission to secure a space for a new student and is not refundable;
- c. A **20% non-refundable deposit** of the total tuition fees are required upon acceptance.
- d. School Fees amounts are subject to the published rates at the time of payment. For example, payment of the Application and Capital Assessment Fees to secure a space for the following year, may be made at the current school year rate if the new Tuition & Fee Schedule has not yet been released;
- e. **Tuition Fees** are payable in full **by June 30** for children who start at the beginning of the school year;
- f. **Tuition Fees** must be paid in full before the first day of school for children who arrive during the course of the school year;
- g. The Additional Fees must be paid in advance or in accordance with specific School instructions;
- h. The Overall Fees should be paid in euros by bank transfer, online payment credit card or cheque. We do not accept American Express or cash.
- i. The School expressly authorizes the Parents to enter into an agreement with a third party for the payment of the totality of the Overall and Additional Fees applicable to the Student's status. Nevertheless, by signing this Agreement, the Parties expressly undertake, without any possible exemption, to guarantee the payment of the totality of the Overall and Additional Fees invoiced by the School by the third party. In the event of difficulties in recovering any sums encountered by the School, the School shall be authorized to take legal action against the Parents without the latter being able to oppose any agreement for the payment of the Overall Fees and/or Additional Fees by a third party.

8. Partial fees

- a. Enrollment numbers help the School to plan ahead with staffing and the procurement of teaching resources. Therefore, does not authorize the reimbursement of the Overall Fees due to last minute withdrawals;
- b. The School's overhead expenses do not diminish with the departure of students during the course of the school year;
- c. As a result, there is no reduction of the Application Fee, Capital Assessment Fee or Re-enrollment Fee for children who arrive or leave the School in the middle of the school year, or for withdrawals of enrollment, subject to the following;

Late arrivals

- before December 31: the annual Tuition Fee is due in full
- after December 31: 75% of the annual Tuition Fee is due
- after April 15: 40% of the annual Tuition Fee is due

Early departures

- before December 31: The School will reimburse 25% of the annual Tuition Fee providing written notice is given by October 31 of the current year
- after December 31: no refund will be made

Withdrawal from the next school year after enrollment is confirmed

- before June 30: the annual Tuition Fee will be refunded in full
- between June 30 and August 31: 50% of the annual Tuition Fee will be refunded

- d. School bus fees must be paid in advance for the year and are non-refundable;
- e. School lunch fees can be billed pro-rata per month;
- f. There is no reduction or reimbursement for any absence or dismissal.

Additional school services

- a. Additional services, such as the school bus, school lunch and enrichment activities, may be provided by the school during the school year. Charges may vary from year to year ensuring they are cost effective;
- b. These services are optional, paid and operated at the discretion of the School;
- c. The School does not guarantee provision of any service to students who register once the deadline has passed or those who enroll in the course of the school year.

Non-payment

- d. Students may be excluded or not allowed to attend class or participate in School activities, including graduation, if any of the applicable Fees or other charges remain unpaid at the end of the year;
- e. All accounts must be current before school records and transcripts can be released or transferred to other schools;
- f. The School may charge interest, at the current legal rate applying, on late payments.

Force Majeure

- g. Expressly, the following are considered as cases of force majeure or fortuitous events: those usually retained by the jurisprudence of the French courts and tribunals, as well as the following events: war,

riots, fires, internal or external strikes, lock-downs, occupation of the premises of one of the parties, bad weather, earthquakes, floods, water damage, legal or governmental restrictions, legal or regulatory changes in forms of marketing, accidents of any kind, epidemics, pandemics, illnesses affecting more than fifteen (15) % of the School's staff in a period of two consecutive months, lack of energy supply, partial or total shutdown of the Internet and, more generally, of private or public telecommunication networks, road blockages and impossibility of supplies and any other case beyond the express will of the Parties preventing the normal execution of this Convention.

- h. The party affected by a case of force majeure shall immediately notify the other party by email or by any other means, confirmed by registered letter with acknowledgement of receipt and providing supporting documents. The other party reserves the right to verify and control the reality of the facts.
- i. With the exception of the obligation of the Parents to pay in full the Overall Fees and the Additional Fees, for which the Parents remain liable and committed, the party affected by the case of force majeure will make every effort to reduce as much as possible the harmful effects resulting from this situation.
- j. The School will make its best efforts to continue, as far as possible and in accordance with the applicable legal and regulatory provisions, to provide educational services to the Student and in particular by all available electronic means allowing distance education.

Re-enrollment

- k. Parents must complete the Re-enrollment form and pay the Re-enrollment Fee within a period of 14 days, to reserve a place for their child for the upcoming school year;
- l. Re-enrollment implies acceptance of the Enrollment Agreement effective at that time;
- m. Families who owe any School fees from a previous year may not be allowed to re-enroll their children until full payment of the outstanding amount;
- n. The School may refuse to re-enroll a Student if it deems that the Student or Parent has breached terms of the Enrollment Agreement or violated any of the School Policies.
