Feminine	Sthreelingam స్త్రీలింగం	Eg: ammayi, chelli, akka ఉద: అమ్మాయి , చెల్లి , అక్క
Collective - High-class plural (living things)	Samooohika Bahuvachanam సామూహిక బహువచనం	Eg: pillalu, aadavaallu, magavallu ఉద: పిల్లలు , ఆడవాళ్లు , మగువలు
Lower-class plural	Bahuvachanam బహువచనం	Eg: illu, aavulu ఉద: ఇల్లు, ఆవులు
Lower-class singular	Ekavachanam ఏకవచనం	Eg: raayi, dabba ఉద: రాయి, డబ్బా
