Class Objective: In this class, we will discuss the verb and its parts.

Concept A: Verb (فعل)

Definition of Verb: The **Verb** الفعل /Al-fi'Il/ is what refers to something happening and the **Time** is part of. Like, thanked شكرَ /shakara, wrote كتب /kataba, Went ذهب /zahaba, came جاء /ja'aa

Kataba (كتب) Example: Kataba Zaidun (كتب زيد) (Zaid wrote)

Yaktubu (يكتب) Example: Yaktubu Zaidun (يكتب زيد) (Zaid is writing or will right)

Uktub (أكتب) Example: Uktub Ya Zaid (اكتب يا زيد) (Write Zaid)

Concept:B Types of verbs in Arabic - namely past, present and imperative.

Definition of Verb

a) **Past Tense (Al mazi) الماضي** : A verb which refers to a finished action in the past. Like, Zahaba. Zaraba.

b) **Present Tense (Al mudhare) المضارع** : A verb which refers to an unfinished action either at present or in the future. Like, Yaftahu, Yashrabu.

c) **Imperative (Al amr) الأمر** : A verb that refers to a request or a command. Like, Qul(say). Izhab (go).

We use verbs according to time, gender, and work. Blew is the example of all types of verbs (past, present, and imperative), used in different times for different work and action.
