Concept A: Grammar

·Vた-Form ばかりです

This sentence pattern means that not much time has passed since a certain action or event occurred. It is the expression of the speaker's feeling and can be used regardless of the real length of time that has passed if the speaker feels it is short. In this respect, this sentence pattern is different from Vt-Form ところです、which can only indicate the time when a certain action has just been completed.

1. さっき 昼(ひる)ごはんを 食(た)べた ばかりです。

I had lunch only a while ago.

2. 木村(きむら)さんは 先月(せんげつ) この 会社(かいしゃ)に 入(はい)った ばかりです。

Ms.Kimura joined this company only a month ago.

[Note] ばかりです is a noun sentence and is used in various structures.

3. この ビデオは 先週(せんしゅう) 買(か)った ばかりなのに、調子(ちょうし)が おかしいです。 I bought this video only a week ago, but it isn't working well.
