Wir	-en-n
Ihr	-t
sie/Sie	-en -n

	Endings	Example geh ^{en}	Example mach ^{en}
Ich	-e	Geh ^e	Mach ^e
du	-st	Geh st	Mach st
er/sie/es	-t	Geh ^t	Mach ^t
Wir	-en	Geh ^{en}	Mach ^{en}
Ihr	-t	Geh ^t	Mach ^t
sie/Sie	-en	geh ^{en}	mach ^{en}

	3rd	he	→	er
		she	→	sie
		it	→	es
Plural	1st	we	→	wir
	2nd	you all (informal)	→	ihr
		You all (formal)	→	Sie
	3rd	they	→	sie
