## Concept A: What is a noun phrase

Noun phrase is known as 名词性短语 (míngcí-xìng duǎnyǔ) in Chinese.

A **noun phrase** is a phrase with a noun or pronoun as a head word that has any sort of modifier.

- A noun phrase consists of a main noun, and any words or phrases that describe or modify the main noun.
- In Chinese, all noun modifiers occur before the main noun.
  Modifier + Noun

Grammar Point (English)	Pattern	Examples
Expressing "some" with "yixie"	一些 + Noun	这里有 <mark>一些</mark> 咖啡。

### Concept C: Nouns can be modified by - Specifiers / Number + Measure Word

- Nouns
- Pronouns
- Adjective Phrases
- Verb Phrases (verb + object)
- Verb Phrases (subject + object)
- Preposition Phrases

Modifier = Specifiers / Number + Measure Word
