English	Malayalam
I was a teacher.	Njan oru adhyapika aayirunnu.
I went to the market.	Njan <mark>vipaniyilekku poyi</mark> .
I was on leave yesterday.	Njan innale avadhiyil aayirunnu.
I did not do this.	Njan ithu cheythilla.

Remember:

Und - present tense undayirunnu - past tense

Concept B: First Person - Plural (We - Njangal)

English	Malayalam
We were busy.	Njangal thirakkil aayirunnu.
We were in the zoo yesterday.	Njan innale mrigalayathil aayirunnu.
We did not see him.	Njangal avane kandilla.
We lived in Chennai last year.	Njangal kazhinja varsham chennail aayirunnu.

Concept C: Second Person - Singular (You - Nee)

English	Malayalam
Were you busy?.	Ningal thirakil aayirunno?
You were late today.	Ningal <mark>innu vaikiyirunnu</mark> .
Did you sleep well?.	Ningal nallonam urangiyo?
You did not talk to me	Nee enodu samsarichilla.
