Basic Sentence formation

Class objective - I am able to form basic sentences in Gujarati.

Concept A: Introduction to basic sentence formation.

In Gujarati most of the sentences end with a verb. Adjectives precede nouns, direct objects come before verbs, and there are postpositions.

The word order of Gujarati is **SOV**. (Subject+object+verb)

Examples:

I eat an ice-cream Hu ice-cream khau chhu.

She goes to the market. Te bajar jay chhe.

Concept B: Subject+object+verb

English sentences	Gujarati sentences
I bought vegetables.	મેં શાકભાજી <mark>ખરીદયા હતા</mark> . Me shakbhaji <mark>kharidya hata</mark> .
She drinks a cup of tea.	તે એક કપ યા પીવે છે. Te eka cup cha pive che.
We sang a song.	
They ran in the house.	અમે ગીત ગાયુ <mark>ં હતું</mark> . Ame geet gayu <mark>hatu.</mark>
	તેઓ ઘરમાં દોડી ગયા <mark>હતા</mark> . Teo gharma dodi gaya <mark>hata.</mark>

Concept C: While making sentences using adjectives.

Subject + Adjective + Object + Verb

English sentences	Gujarati sentences
She ate a delicious ice-cream.	તેણે એક સ્વાદિષ્ટ આઈસ્ક્રીમ ખાધો . Tene ek swadista ice-cream khadho.
They stay in a beautiful palace.	તેઓ એક સુંદર મહેલમાં રહે છે.
He works with honesty.	Teo ek sundar mahelma rahe che.
He writes meaningless letters.	તે પ્રામાણિકતા સાથે કામ કરે છે. Te pramanikta sathe kaam kare che.
Ben is an adorable baby.
