## **Class Objective**

To learn the concept of writing short notes, postcards, messages.



Let's see how to write a paragraph or short notes in Spanish.

#### 1. Verb Conjugation First

- ~ To succeed at composing a basic paragraph/notes in Spanish, you
- must first decide what tense is the most appropriate.

#### 2. Opening Sentence

- The opening sentence in your paragraph/notes lets your reader know
- what exactly you are going to discuss.



**Example:** Para comenzar, la autora incluye personajes fantásticos en su libro. El personaje Barrabás es un perro inusual por su tamaño; el perro es simplemente enorme. (To begin, the author includes fantastic characters in her book. The character Barrabas is an unusual dog due to his size; the dog is simply enormous.')



~ As you can see, expressions like para comenzar (to begin) to connect paragraphs. You can use words like these:

- En primera instancia (In a first instance)
- En primer lugar (In the first place)
- Para empezar (To start)
- Primeramente (Firstly)



# **Writing Sentences** As for writing sentences? you can keep things simple in your composition by following basic sentence structure: a subject, a verb in the correct tense, and a complement (or predicate).
